Resolution approving an increase in the solid waste fund user charge.

WHEREAS, Section 15.03 authorizes the Common Council to revise the solid waste user charges necessary to insure that the system generates adequate revenues to pay the cost of operation and maintenance; and,

WHEREAS, the 2010 budget, approved by the Common Council on November 17, 2009, requires an increase in the solid waste user charge to pay the cost of operation and maintenance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of West Allis that an increase of 94 cents in the quarterly solid waste user charge from \$15.53 per residential unit to \$16.47 per residential unit, an increase of 6% over 2009 be and is hereby approved, said increase to be effective January 1, 2010.
