Dear Mayor and Alderpersons:

Michelle Moran was involved in an automobile accident on July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2005. She was covered by the City's health insurance policy and the City paid out health benefits related to the accident. Therefore, the City was named in Ms. Moran's lawsuit and the City sought to recover the amounts it had paid in health benefits related to the accident. The City claimed that it was entitled to approximately \$14,000.00 in health benefits. The matter was mediated and the City Attorney's Office agreed to \$7,000.00 in settlement of the City's claim.
