Dear Mayor Bell:

Time Warner Cable continues to bring our customers into the digital age by upgrading their equipment to our state-of-the art technology. As a result, Time Warner Cable has begun phasing out our outdated analog converters and replacing them with our digital converters.

This transition is great news for HBO and Showtime customers with analog converters! Effective May 1, 2003 Time Warner Cable HBO on channel 66 and Showtime on channel 67 will no longer be available. Instead, HBO and Showtime will be available exclusively on Digital Cable. Customers will be given a Digital Converter and get the same HBO and/or Showtime services <u>plus</u> 14 additional channels of HBO and 16 additional channels of Showtime at <u>no</u> additional cost!!

The Digital converter is the same price as the analog converter. In addition, the premium price for HBO and Showtime will also remain the same. Customers are being notified by letter and by telephone by our sales department to schedule the exchange of the equipment. The following bill message will be sent to all customers regarding HBO and Showtime.

"Beginning on May 1, 2003, HBO and Showtime will be available exclusively as Time Warner Digital Cable Services, which will bring viewers additional channels and crisper pictures. HBO (channel 66) and Showtime (channel 68) will no longer be available on your lineup. HBO and Showtime subscriptions will require a Digital converter, which can be used on any TV. With the Digital converter HBO customers will now receive 14 channels of HBO and Showtime customers will receive 16 channels of Showtime. Please contact 800-627-2288 to arrange for conversion to Time Warner Digital Cable."

Time Warner Cable is very excited about this transition. We know that the Digital world holds many new possibilities that will enable our customers to access new state-of-the art products with the touch of their remote control. We, at Time Warner Cable believe that "Now, Anything is Possible."
