Dear City Council Members,

I am writing to ask you to reconsider the proposal to remove the traffic lights at the intersection of S. 60th Street and Lapham Street. Our concern focuses on the students attending Horace Mann Elementary School which is located on Lapham Street between 62nd and 63rd Streets. If the traffic lights are eliminated at this intersection, school children will have to either walk north to Greenfield Avenue or south to Mitchell Street. We feel it is unlikely children will follow this longer route and will instead continue to cross at this now uncontrolled intersection. This creates significant safety concerns for our school children.

We propose to retain these traffic lights, but to have them operate on a "timed" basis. The times they would need to be fully active would be from approximately 7:00a.m.to 9:00a.m.and 2:30p.m.to 4:30p.m. During times these lights are not needed, they could function with a yellow/red flashing signal. In addition the lights would not need to be fully functional during the summer months.

Please consider this proposal as we feel this would best suit both the safety needs of our children and better traffic flow for our vehicle operators. Please contact me with any further questions or information you might need. Thank you so much for your consideration.

Issue: Children Safety -Proposed removal of the traffic light at 60th and Lapham streets

Recommendation: For the safety of the children and citizens crossing a major West Allis roadway, keep the traffic light in place at that intersection.

- Children are crossing all year long to:
 - 1. To attend regular school
 - 2. To use Liberty Heights park
 - 3. Liberty Heights Food Service Program Summer attendance
 - A. 50 at breakfast
 - B. 100 at lunch
 - C. Dinner will potentially be offered this year.
- Horace Mann school changed from a middle school (6-7-8 grade) to a K-5 elementary school. The children are younger then in the past.
- The traffic light was put in purposely to permit safe crossing of students and parents.
- There are 110 students that attend Mann and 44 more potential school aged children who live East of 60th street.
- Attendance fluctuates from year to year and the school district is experiencing growth in elementary students in a declining enrollment school district.
- Distracted driving is more of a concern than ever before and constitutes a major hazard to children.
- Mann Elementary school eastern boundary starts at 56th street and the C & P Railroad then at goes South along to S.57th street to Burnham, then West to 60th street.
