At first, I participated in only the crocheting group, but as time passed, I now volunteer in helping in the office, leading a Mexican Train Domino group, and donating to Gifts of Warmth which finds homes for warm mittens, scarfs, hats, afghans, and quilts.

As I work in the office, I see many people who look on the center as a second home. The center provides a safe haven for seniors to have a well-balanced complete meal, participate in games and activities, take a class, exercise, and socialize. Some people would not be able to do some of these without the Center.

I know I would be lost without the Center and I can get in my car easily, but some of the people can't drive and would be stuck in their homes without nearby access to the Center. Older people need to get out too.
