Dear Members:

As part of the Hall Steel litigation, this office hired Dettmann & Associates, LLC, as well as, Reginald Draheim to be experts with regard to Relocation law. Since September of 2006, both Delbert Dettmann of Dettmann & Associates, LLC and Reginald Draheim have provided services to the City/CDA with regard to the Hall Steel litigation. In November of 2006, Delbert Dettman was hired as the City's Real Estate Agent I. The Real Estate Agent I position does not include any job duties related to relocation.

The purpose of this letter is to inform the council that Delbert Dettmann is working part-time (.5 FTE) as a Real Estate Agent I and is also being contracted with under Dettmann & Associates, LLC as an expert in the Hall Steel case.
