RE: City Attorney's Report of Claim

Dear Council Members:

The enclosed claim has been referred to this office in accordance with Section 3.05(8) of the Revised Municipal Code. This office has examined the facts of the claim and the applicable law. Our Opinion regarding liability is as follows:

It is the recommendation of this office that the following claim be denied:

Nate Mertens - Amount: \$1,000.00 (approximately)

This is a claim for damages to the claimant's vehicle when it was severely flooded while parked on the street on June 7th, 2008, in the 2100 block of South 83rd Street, West Allis, WI. Due to construction being done on the street in June of 2008, the contractor placed a black fabric material over the sewers to block the construction sediment from entering the sewer system. This type of inlet protection is a WDNR requirement, which the City enforces on contractors during construction when the possibility of dirt entering the sewer system is present. The claimant believes that the fabric mesh blocked the sewers on the day in question resulting in the ultimate flooding of his vehicle. On August 9th, 2008, the claimant filed a Notice of Claim and then followed the same up with a Demand for Damages on June 12th, 2009.


This claim was investigated by both the Department of Public Works and Engineering, which both came to the same conclusion that the City bears no legal responsibility for this incident. No municipal sewer system was designed to handle the extreme rain that occurred in the City on June 7th, 2008. Many homes and streets, etc. were flooded as a result of said storms. Liability, if any, would fall to the independent contractor working on the streets but even if said fabric was not in place, it is extremely likely that the streets would have flooded in the similar manner on the day in question. In other words, this is an act of God, which would be best handled by the claimant's automobile insurance provider.


Based upon the above, it is the recommendation of the City Attorney's Office to deny this claim pursuant to the provisions of Wisconsin Municipal Claims Statute 893.80.



On June 7, 2008, the 2200 block of S. 83rd St. was severely flooded. There was some street/sewage construction being done on the 2100 block of S. 83rd during the time of the flooding and the workers had covered the street drains on the 2200 block with some type of black mesh. This mesh did not allow the street to properly drain and the city was called June 5, 2008 (two days prior) because my block was flooding due to the rain we were receiving that week. A city worker arrived and pulled back the mesh from the drains allowing the street to drain and then replaced the mesh once things had dried up.

During the late afternoon hours on June 7, 2008, I began to hear tornado sirens blaring across the town. When I turned on the News, there were tornado warnings and the newscasters were telling everyone to get into their basements for protection, which I promptly did. I could see and immense amount of rain coming down and even noticed a small amount seeping into the corner of the basement. Seeing the water coming into the basement, I remembered that my car was parked on the street causing me to think about the partial flooding two days prior.

I quickly ran up stairs and outside to see my whole block completely flooded. The water was coming up the driveways and my car, along with several of my neighbors' vehicles, was partially under water (past the middle of the rims of my tires). At the same time, several of my neighbors were coming out of their homes and we all jumped into action mode. (Pictures of the flooding are included to show how severe it was)

We began pushing the cars that were parked in the street out of the flooded road to dry areas in the blocks East, West, and South of the 2200 block of S. 83rd St. Once we removed the cars from the flooded area, we began poking holes in the mesh that covered the street drains or ripping the material out. After about one half-hour, the block had drained completely and you could see the water was almost at the top of the street drains.

Due to the flooding, my vehicle suffered severe damage. The vehicle is a green 1997 Acura CL, license plate is a Wisconsin plate, number 733-MDZ. The inside of the car was completely flooded up to the bottom of the seats (pictures of the car are present to show the extent of the flooding) and the vehicle would not start and the engine would not turn over. I personally replaced the starter and the car started up but would not stay running. Eventually I had the vehicle towed to Auto Analyzers at the intersection of 84th and Greenfield in West Allis.

They informed me that the car's main computer had taken in water and needed to be cleaned and dried out before they could assess the full damage. They were able to

salvage the computer and get the car running but my stereo, keyless entry, alarm system, and air conditioning were all shorted out due to water damage. I also missed 2 days of work as I was trying to get things in order with my vehicle and paid all expenses out of pocket.

About one month later, I began experiencing problems with the clutch system of my car and had to take the care in again. This time I took the car to A-1 Radiator and Auto Repair located 8205 W. Lincoln Ave in West Allis. They informed that the hydraulic system had taken in an unusual amount of dirt due to the flooding and that the entire hydraulic system was ruined and needed to be replaced, which I again paid out of pocket to fix and missed another two days of work.

Our block would not have flooded if the street drains had not been covered. City workers had been to the 2200 block of S. 83rd St. two days prior to the severe flooding because the block was already beginning to flood and had pulled back the mesh that was covering the drains to allow the street to drain. That fact paired with the photo proof shows that the liability to the damage of my car lies with the City of West Allis. I am seeking compensation for the damages I have already paid for along with the other parts of my vehicle that have been damaged due to the flooding (the stereo, air-conditioning, alarm system, and keyless entry). I will submit estimates on the repair of the parts that are still not fixed along with receipts from the damages I have already paid for.
