In the face of pending federal legislation that is detrimental local municipalities and Access Channel operations the WACCC has contact their Congressional Representatives to vote against and not support any legislation that goes against local franchising controls.

Two groups, the Rotary Club and West Allis Women's Club have members training on the video production equipment. Eight people took the field production training in July, and nine people took the studio production training in August. 46 programs were produced in the 3rd Quarter along with promotional pieces for their Halloween fundraiser and 25th Anniversary in March of 2007. Planning for the 25th Anniversary continues.

The WACCC is continuing to fulfill the requirements stated in their 2006 goals and objectives. I recommend providing $3^{\rm rd}$ quarter funding for the WACCC.
