
Teen Summer Reading 2024 Wrap-Up:



Teen Summer Reading 2024 ran from June 1st to September 7th, with early registration in May. We had 359 teens register for the program, and 219 were active readers. 211 readers reached our first prize level, with 188 returning to the library for that first level prize, a Wisconsin State Fair Ticket.

Prizes and Winners:

Teens who read 3 books earned a state fair ticket and a sticker. We added the sticker to give readers who came in after the Wisconsin State Fair something to take home. At 6 books read teens earned a small pack of coupons provided by MCFLS, and at 9 books they were able to pick out a free book. This year's fourth prize was a pin and two bonus coupons.

In addition to the prizes at 3, 6, 9 and 12 books read teens earned entries into a grand prize drawing. From all of the summer reading entries, we picked four winners for \$25 gift cards: Karazi, Isabelle, Andrew and Trey.

We were able to visit 2 schools in the West Allis West Milwaukee School District. Frank Lloyd Wright Intermediate invited us to register students in person on May 16th. We also did an online visit with the Virtual Academy in West Allis on May 14th. Email with Summer Reading information was sent out to all West Allis West Milwaukee Intermediate and High schools as well.

It's no surprise that Frank Lloyd Wright was the school with the most readers. I was surprised that we had 151 readers who choose other as their school. There is also a concern for the number of readers who are identifying as Adults, and sill in elementary school.

As a note, 276 of our readers list West Allis as their city of residence. For the future I would like to get a better picture of where these students are attending school, if they are not in the local school district.

Programs and Attendance:

During summer 2024 the library hosted 16 events for teens, and on event for students in grades 4-8, or tweens. We had 160 teens attend. This is up from last summer where we hosted 19 events and had 106 attendees.

The biggest successes were our Anime Clubs, where we added a special treat each month, as well as our Teen Art Club where popular crafts drew new attendees. Movie afternoons were not a success, and going forward we will need to rethink how to show movies for teens.
