
Notification Pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act, 29 U.S.C.§ 2101 et seq. and applicable state law

Dear Mayor Bell:

As you may be aware, Fleming Companies, Inc., as a major step in its Chapter 11 bankruptcy process, has announced plans to sell certain assets of its wholesale grocery distribution operations, including its business at 1710 South 108th Street, West Allis.

In connection with the sale process, it is anticipated that an asset purchase agreement with a potential purchaser will be presented for approval to the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware. If approved by the Bankruptcy Court as anticipated at a hearing scheduled for August 4, 2003, the asset purchase agreement will provide for a 6 month "Option Period", during which time a purchaser will acquire or decide not to acquire the above-noted facility. The purchaser will have the right but will not be required to extend offers of employment to Fleming employees to work at the acquired facilities under terms and conditions to be determined by the purchaser.

Accordingly, Fleming will be terminating 184, at the above noted facility, as well as additional Fleming employees at other facilities during the Option Period, including those Fleming employees who receive offers of employment from the purchaser, as these determinations are made by the purchaser, with the first such terminations expected to occur by September 10, 2003 or within 14 days thereafter, and all Fleming employees working in Fleming's wholesale grocery distribution operations to be terminated by the close of the Option Period or within 14 days These terminations will be permanent and will affect employees in all job classifications. As Fleming will no longer be operating this facility, any bumping rights provided under current labor agreements with Fleming will not be applicable. Any wholesale grocery facilities not sold to a purchaser, will be closed by Fleming. A list of the job classifications of those employees who will be affected is attached.



Of the 184 associates at this location, 168 bargaining unit employees are represented by BCTWIU Local 205. The following is the name and address of the employees' collective bargaining representative:

We are hopeful that many Fleming employees will receive offers of employment from a purchaser. This notice is being provided at this time in order to give as much advance notice as possible to everyone affected by this development and to fulfill any obligation that Fleming might have pursuant to Federal Workers Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act, more commonly known as the "WARN Act," and any similar state statute that may apply.

During the Option Period, as decisions are made regarding specific facilities, Fleming employees will be provided with updated information regarding the date of their termination of employment with Fleming.
