WHEREAS, the City of West Allis will maintain records documenting all expenditures made during the Brownfield site Assessment Grant period; and,

WHEREAS, the City of West Allis will allow employees from the Department of Natural Resources access to inspect the grant site or facility and grant records; and,

WHEREAS, the City of West Allis will submit a final report to the Department of Natural Resources which will accompany the final payment request.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of West Allis requests funds and assistance available from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources under the Brownfield Site Assessment Grant Program and will comply with state rules for the program.

Stibal, Director of Development is hereby authorized to act on behalf of the City of West Allis to submit an application for the property described hereby attached in Exhibit A to the State of Wisconsin for financial aid for Brownfield Site Assessment Grant purposes; sign documents; and take necessary action to undertake, direct, and complete approved grant activities.

Project Description:

The Department of Development is intending to seek a Site Assessment Grant (SAG) from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) for the residential property located at 1501 S. 113<sup>th</sup> Street (tax key # 448-9990-000). The City will be requesting \$29,000 to cover the cost of asbestos removal, demolition and site investigation. The property is currently owned by JP Morgan Chase Bank or GMAC Mortgage. The subject property is an approximate 0.5-acre with a home and attached garage which has been used as a salvage yard and/or vehicle storage business until the previous owner was foreclosed on and evicted from the property. The property had been determined to be impacted by a release of chlorinated volatile organic compounds (CVOCs) which be remediated in conjuction with proposed remedial action planned for the adjacent Home Juice Site. The 1501 S. 113<sup>th</sup> Street property has also been discovered to have elevated concentrations of metals in three water samples collected from the site. The SAG grant will be used, in part, to investigate the

degree and extent of metals impacts in the groundwater.
