Resolution to approve bid of MJ Construction, Inc. for the asphalt resurfacing of the pavement including miscellaneous driveway and sidewalk repair, sanitary sewer, and utility adjustments in S. 77th St. from W. Beloit Rd. to W. Arthur Ave., S. 78th St. from W. Lincoln Ave. to W. Arthur Ave., S. 79th St. from W. Lincoln Ave. to W. Arthur Ave., S. 80th St. from W. Hayes Ave. to W. Arthur Ave. and S. 81st St. from 300' South of W. Lincoln Ave. to W. Arthur Ave. in the City of West Allis, in the amount of \$1,080,415.00.

WHEREAS, The Board of Public Works reports that it duly advertised for bids for the furnishing of certain materials and the performance of all work required for the improvements in a certain area as hereinafter described; that the bids received as shown on the attached bid report were reasonable and hereby recommends and deems it to be for the best interests of the City of West Allis that the bid of MJ Construction, Inc. for 2013 Project No. 11 be accepted.

- S. 80th Street: W. Hayes Avenue to W. Arthur Avenue
- S. 81st Street: 300' South of W. Lincoln Avenue to W. Arthur Avenue

(PLAN FILE NOS. SP-1186, SP-1187, SP-1188, SP-1189, SP-1190, S-1484, S-1485, S-1486, S-1487, S-1488, S-1489, S-1490, S-1491)

for the sum of One Million Eighty Thousand Four Hundred Fifteen and 00/100 dollars (\$1,080,415.00)

be accepted, and the proper City officers are hereby authorized and directed to enter into contractual relations with said contractor for the performance of said work, in accordance with the prices submitted in their proposal and with the specifications of the City of West Allis, and that all other bids received for same be rejected; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That said improvements be installed with funding by Sanitary Sewer Funds, Storm Water Management Funds, Water Utility Funds, Bond Funds and Funds from Special Assessments.
