Alderman Kurt Kopplin received a complaint from the homeowner at 7920 W. Hayes Avenue about the condition of the alley right next to his house. The homeowner claims that water leaks from the center of the alley toward his property. The catch basin needs to be rebuilt and the adjacent alley pavement replaced. The rest of the alley is in good condition.
