Dear Council Members:

The enclosed claim has been referred to this office in accordance with Section 3.05(8) of the Revised Municipal Code. This office has examined the facts of the claim and the applicable law. Our Opinion regarding liability is as follows:

It is the recommendation of this office that the following claim be denied:

Steve McComb - Amount: \$2,220.00

This is a claim for property damage to various items contained within the claimant's basement at 10408 Schlinger Avenue, West Allis, WI on or about June 19th, 2009, when the claimants had a substantial amount of water in their basement from an alleged sewer back-up. On July 6th, 2009, the claimants filed a claim along with pictures and a list of contents and prices to replace the damaged items alleging negligence on the part of the City for a defective sewer system.

Our investigation into this claim revealed that the interceptor sewer maintained by MMSD became overloaded on the day in question from the unusual amount of rain in the area. This overloading prevented the interceptor sewer from properly discharging, which in turn, caused the City's system to become overloaded resulting in flooding in many areas throughout the City. The investigation further indicated that sewer systems in general are not designed to handle the extreme amount of water flow that occurred in this area from the rains in June of 2009. Although the storms have caused a great deal of stress and flooding for many people in the area, no negligence can be attributed to the City for this true act of God.

Based upon the above, it is the recommendation of the City Attorney's Office to deny this claim pursuant to the provisions of Wisconsin Municipal Claims Statute 893.80.

In viewing the evening news on Channel 12 on Monday evening, June 22, 2009, it was reported that the people of West Allis that had experienced flood damage turn in their reports/claims to the City of West Allis for federal relief. After receiving no help and/or assistance from our State Farm agent, we take this opportunity to do just that – seek federal relief by reporting our damages to you, per Channel 12's news forecast.

Enclosed please find an itemized Inventory List of every item we lost in the flood in the early morning hours of Friday, June 19, 2009, when we awoke at 2:30 a.m. to a flooded basement. Also enclosed is a set of pictures we took of our flood damage. We have lost everything we had in this basement. We seek relief to help compensate for our loss. To recover from this devastating loss, out of our own pockets, would be too great. We have resided in this home since September 2008 so we have never experienced this flood damage issue in West Allis that apparently continues to go on, nor were we ever told about it from our Landlord. We never want to go through this again. It has devastated us.
