

## LETTER 2 — NOTICE OF CLAIM TO RISK MANAGEMENT

**RE: Formal Notice of Claim — Civil Rights Violations May 30, 2026 — 84th and Orchard Street West Allis WI**

My name is Jesse Bester Jr. P.O. Box 1031 Milwaukee, WI 53201

I am writing to formally place the City of West Allis on notice of my intent to pursue legal action arising from serious civil rights violations committed by West Allis Police Department officers on May 30, 2026, at approximately 2:00 AM at or near 84th and Orchard Street, West Allis, Wisconsin.

### Summary of Incident:

1. Unlawful traffic stop without probable cause
2. Unlawful search of my person and rental vehicle without consent — I clearly and repeatedly refused consent
3. Excessive force — extremely tight handcuffing causing injury to both wrists and hands
4. Inappropriate touching of my private areas without consent or legal justification
5. Deliberate indifference to my disability — I have Multiple Sclerosis and was forced to urinate on myself while restrained after repeatedly informing officers of my medical condition
6. Officers refused to provide badge numbers or names when requested
7. Officers fled the scene without providing documentation
8. Approximately four to five officers in four separate vehicles present — coordinated stop

**Medical Impact:** I was transported to the hospital following this incident. I have Multiple Sclerosis diagnosed since 2012. The deliberate indifference to my medical condition during this stop caused physical and neurological distress. Hospital records from May 30, 2026, document my injuries.

### Legal Basis For Claim:

- 42 U.S.C. § 1983 — Civil Rights Violations
- Fourth Amendment — Unlawful Search and Seizure
- Americans With Disabilities Act — Failure to Accommodate Known Disability
- 18 U.S.C. § 242 — Deprivation of Rights Under Color of Law

- Physical injury to wrists and hands

- Deliberate indifference to serious medical condition
- Pain and suffering
