### STREET & SEWER MAINTAINER

<u>JOB SUMMARY:</u> This is responsible manual and skilled work employing a variety of tasks and practices associated with the cleaning, maintenance, and repair of sanitary and storm sewers, streets, alleys, and sidewalks of the City's Street & Sewer Section in the Sanitation & Streets Division of the Department of Public Works/Engineering.

NATURE OF THE WORK: An employee in this classification is responsible for the performance of skilled maintenance and repair work associated with street and sewer construction repair, the cleaning, maintenance and repair of sanitary and storm sewers, and in overseeing, directing activities of crew persons, and providing assistance to other employees engaged in such work.

<u>DUTIES</u>: Acts as a leadman responsible for providing technical assistance and guidance to other members of a small crew engaged in the cleaning, maintenance and repair of sanitary and storm sewers, streets, alleys, and sidewalks. Typical duties include: builds and repairs sanitary and storm sewers, sewer lines, storm sewer manholes and catch basins; builds the necessary form work, pours and finishes concrete; repairs, installs, and terminates storm and sewer laterals; patches streets, alleys, other pavements, curbs and sidewalks with epoxy cements; lays asphalt; removes roots, debris and other refuse from clogged sewer lines operating portable bucket machines, or hydraulic sewer jets as required; installs, removes and replaces knives and performs minor running repairs on equipment using common hand tools; removes sewer residue, examines for evidence of breaks and measures approximate location of break; rods and flushes sewer lines; backfills and compacts excavations; operates trucks and a variety of equipment associated with construction/maintenance work; performs emergency work of all types including snow plowing and removal, salt and sanding operations, and flood control (sanitary sewer pumping and creek ice removal); keeps daily records and makes reports, assists in system map changes/updates; responds to sewer back up calls from the public; inspects construction projects.

As needed, an employee in this classification may be required to perform a variety of tasks outside of the duties of a Street & Sewer Maintainer for which he/she is otherwise qualified; other duties may include, but are not limited to, collects refuse and recyclables; collects, hauls and delivers a variety of materials, equipment, supplies and waste products; loads and unloads trucks by hand or by use of mechanical devices; operates Vac-All; assists residents with proper disposal, composting or recycling of materials brought to the Municipal Yard site; transports personnel to various destinations within the City; performs general maintenance and repair of City-owned buildings and surrounding grounds, etc.; and performs other duties as assigned.

A Street & Sewer Maintainer must be available to work nights, weekends, overtime and at odd hours when emergency situations require such duty and to serve on watch duty when assigned.

#### DESIRABLE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Considerable working knowledge of the methods, tools and equipment commonly used in public works construction, maintenance work, and in cleaning sewer lines; ability to operate a truck and the machines used in sewer cleaning operations; ability to operate a refuse packer, front-end loader, back hoe, tracked loader, hook truck and tar kettle; training in confined space entry and designated as a competent person; skill in the use of common hand tools and equipment; ability to operate heavy motorized equipment; ability to perform a variety of skilled construction tasks and to interpret work from rough sketches or penciled layouts; ability to read and understand blueprints as they relate to sewers; ability to operate both standard and automatic transmissions; considerable knowledge of occupational hazards and safe work practices; ability to perceive hazards involved in working in streets, manholes and trenches and to take precautionary measures; mechanical aptitude; ability to work with a minimum of supervision; ability to oversee the work of others and to assist in the training of subordinates; ability to understand and effectively carry out verbal and written instructions; and ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with supervisors, employees and the public.

## MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

High school, trade school graduate/equivalent and at least (5) five years of recent paid work experience in municipal street and sewer maintenance/repair <u>OR</u>, an equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the requisite knowledge, skills and abilities.

Possession of a valid Wisconsin Commercial Driver's License (Class B, C, D with airbrakes); Class A is desirable.

Possession of Tanker (N) endorsement within 6 months of appointment.

Possess a good driving record per City policy.

Demonstrated experience operating heavy motorized equipment such as dump trucks, end loaders, backhoes and rollers.

Ability to recognize and identify degrees of similarities or differences between characteristics of colors, forms, sounds and textures associated with job-related objects, materials and tasks.

Possess the physical capacity to perform the duties of the position including but not limited to, the ability to continuously stand, walk, bend, kneel, sit, climb, twist, stoop, crawl, squat, lift, reach, stretch, push, pull, enter and exit City truck, etc.

Possess the physical capacity to perform heavy manual labor for extended periods of time (physical requirements are dependent upon work assigned) including but not limited to, the duties generalized below.

### PHYSICAL DEMAND LEVEL

Light Lifting	20 lbs occasionally; up to 10 lbs frequently
Medium Lifting	50 lbs. occasionally; 20 lbs. frequently
Heavy Lifting	100 lbs. occasionally; 50 lbs. frequently
Very Heavy Lifting	100 lbs. occasionally

## **ACTIVITY TOLERANCES/FREQUENCIES**

Continuous	67 - 100% of workday
Frequent	34 – 66% of workday
Occasionally	1 - 33% of workday

Asphalt Truck: continuous (8 hrs/day) medium lifting/shoveling; continuous walking

Back-hoe: continuous sitting; continuous operation (pushing) of hand controls/joystick

Brush Collection/Yard Work: continuous light lifting; continuous walking

<u>Dump Truck Driver:</u> occasional light lifting in the spreading of gravel; frequent light lifting in removing small concrete pieces and excess ground

<u>Front End Loader:</u> continuous sitting; frequent to continuous operation (pushing) of a hand controls/joystick.

<u>Hook Truck:</u> occasional very heavy pushing (100 lbs.+) when pushing open/closing the rear gate on the container

Recycling: continuous medium lifting; continuous bending

Refuse Collection: continuous pushing, pulling and bending; continuous heavy lifting of carts

Roller: frequent sitting; frequent climbing onto and off of equipment; occasional pushing; occasional arm rotation

<u>Sewer Jet:</u> continuous standing and walking; continuous very heavy pulling/lifting of sewer covers; continuous motion when operating hose

<u>Snow Plow Driver:</u> continuous sitting for up to 18 hours, or longer if conditions warrant such; continuous high level of mental and physical alertness (such as hand-eye coordination) is required during plowing operations; continuous and repetitive pushing/operating plow controls; continuous use of accelerator/brake

<u>Tar Kettle:</u> continuous medium lifting; occasional heavy lifting (80 pound block of tar 2-3 times/day); occasional light lifting of barricades and traffic cones

<u>Tracked Loader:</u> continuous sitting; continuous operation (pushing) of hand controls/joystick and foot controls

 $\underline{\text{Vac-All:}}$  continuous medium lifting with ability to move Vac-All tube around in a hole; occasional heavy lifting when lifting catch basins

Ability to work nights, weekends, overtime, and at odd hours when emergency conditions require such duty and to serve on watch duty when assigned.

Ability to withstand exposure to variable and unfavorable weather and working conditions including but not limited to, temperature variations and extremes, odors, toxic agents, noise, vibrations, electrical current, vehicular traffic and/or dust.

Completion of CVMIC Pre-supervisory Certification or equivalent within two (2) years of appointment.
