This correspondence is Notice, pursuant to the Worker Adjustment Retraining Notification Act, 29 U.S.C. 2101 et seq. and Wis. Stat. 109.07, that Metal Technologies, Inc. will be permanently closing its entire Milwaukee Ductile Iron, Inc. Plant, a subsidiary of Metal Technologies, Inc. located at 1706 S. 68th Street, West Allis, Wisconsin 53214, sometime during the 14-day period beginning on July 31, 2009.

This plant closure is expected to affect as many as 215 employees. A computer printout listing the job titles affected, the employee currently holding the affected position, and each employee's expected separation date is attached hereto as Exhibit A. There are no bumping rights.
