Upon deliberation and consideration of the evidence presented at the hearing held on March 3, 2009, the Committee finds:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. That the allegations in the complaint were admitted by Leonard Malan and are true;
- 2. That the conduct of Lenny's Inc. and Leonard Malan described in the complaint substantially relates to the alcohol beverage licensed activity contrary to Wis. Stat. § 125.04 (5);
- 3. That, in particular, the numerous police service calls generated at Lenny's in the past two years, the underage persons allowed entry into the bar, and the failure of Leonard Malan to call the police during disturbances of the peace at the bar are contrary to Wis. Stat. § 125.04 (5).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

1. That the evidence submitted at the hearing constitutes a sufficient basis to suspend the liquor license of Lenny's, Inc. for 10 consecutive days.

Therefore, the License and Health Committee recommends to the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the liquor license of Lenny's, Inc. be suspended for 10 consecutive days.
