1. **REVIEW OF NEW LEGISLATION**


- AB213 REMOVING CERTAIN DIFFERENCES BETWEEN CITY AND VILLAGE LAWS**
Refer to Scott Post and Paul Ziehler.
- SB163 REQUIRING HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE OF COLORECTAL CANCER SCREENING AND GRANTING RULE-MAKING AUTHORITY**
OPPOSE, because the bill would be another state health insurance coverage mandate and such decisions should remain with the local municipality.
- SB164 INCREASING THE MAXIMUM CLAIM UNDER THE SCHOOL PROPERTY TAX CREDIT FOR OLDER CLAIMANTS**

- SB169 USE OF A FACSIMILE FIREARM AND PROVIDING A PENALTY**

- SB77** **CHANGES TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT TAX BENEFIT PROGRAMS, PROVIDING AN EXEMPTION FROM EMERGENCY RULE PROCEDURES, AND REQUIRING THE EXERCISE OF RULE-MAKING AUTHORITY**
