An Ordinance to amend subsection 9.02(5)(b)4 of the Revised Municipal Code relative to establishing a late application fee for Temporary Extension of Class B Tavern Licensed Premises for Special Events.

The Common Council of the City of West Allis do ordain as follows:

PART I. Subsection 9.02(5)(b)4 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City of West Allis is hereby amended to read:

9.02 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

* * *

(5) Extension of Premises.

* * *

(b) Temporary Extension of Class B Tavern Licensed Premises for Special Events.

* * *

4. Application. Application for the temporary extension of Class B tavern licensed premises shall be made in writing to the City Clerk on forms provided by the City Clerk. The application shall be signed by the applicant, if an individual, or by a duly authorized agent or officer, if a corporation or limited liability company, and shall be sworn to by the applicant. Such application shall contain the name of the licensee, the address of the existing licensed premises, the particular event or function for which the temporary extension of the licensed premises is sought, the date and period of time sought for the temporary extension of the licensed premises, a specific description of the area for which the temporary extension is sought, plans describing how the extended premises will be enclosed, and such other reasonable and pertinent information as the Common Council or the License and Health Committee of the Common Council may require. The application shall be filed at least thirty (30) days prior to the date of granting by the Common Council. Any application submitted within thirty (30) days, and no later than forty-eight (48) business hours, prior to the date of granting by the Common Council must be accompanied by a late fee of fifty dollars (\$50) in addition to the license fee.

PART II. All ordinances or parts of ordinances contravening the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

PART III. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
