Between 84th and 92nd street from Becher to Lincoln, S. 90th St receives more traffic than any other street. Grant ends at 90th and all the traffic either goes north or south. The address for the hospital is 2300 S. 90th and increased traffic from National comes down 90th for the hospital, not to mention the traffic from Grant when school is in session from Central High. We receive a high volume of parked cars from the office building on the corner of 90th and Lincoln and the hospital even though they have a new three level parking structure across the street on Lincoln. All of this creates huge blind spots from our driveways of Grant for the addresses listed. Many cars do not stop at the stop sign on Grant and many safety issues are created. Our street is currently under construction and if they narrow it a foot and a half like they did on 89th it will be worse.

Due to the proximity of our homes to Grant we are asking that the restricted one hour, 8-4, Mon-Fri. parking on the west side of 90th be extended from currently 2193 down to and including 2171 S. 90th. after construction is completed and our street is re-opened. Parking on both sides of this street also causes issues for refuse and recycle trucks and plows and emergency vehicles also.
