The Police Department and the License and Health Committee have always worked cooperatively to address community problems associated with taverns and other licensed establishments. The majority of times this has been in a reactive nature after a problem tavern is brought to our attention. In an effort to prevent problems before they occur, I have assigned Lieutenant Charles Padgett to be the Police Liaison to your Committee.

Lieutenant Padgett is assigned to our Detective Bureau, his direct phone number is 302-8074. His normal hours of work are from 4:00 P.M. to midnight. He will attend the majority of your meetings, monitor police reports associated with taverns, meet with Patrol Officers to identify problem taverns, work with tavern owners to prevent problems in the neighborhoods, and provide you with police records pertaining to any licensed establishment.

Enclosed for your information is a Problem Oriented Policing Guide on "Assaults in and Around Bars". At your request, I have also included the police reports associated with Lenny's Tavern located at 6309 W. National Ave. We have made several arrests in the recent shooting incident at this tavern, unfortunately we have not yet arrested the person responsible for discharging the weapon.

P.O. Sitter reports...On 07/24/04 at 0220 hrs, Officers responded to a report of a fight and shots fired at Lenny's Tavern, 6309 W. National Ave. Upon our arrival, four parties, later identified as Willie O. Hughes, M/B, DOB 08/02/74, Annette M. Alvarez, F/W, DOB 12/06/76, Stacie L. Brog, F/W, DOB 03/17/75, and Erica L. Hommel, F/W, DOB 10/18/80, were discovered fighting in front of the tavern. Investigation later revealed that during the fight between Hughes, Alvarez, Brog, and Hommel, an unknown person appears to have fired four shots in the air while across the street from the tavern. There are no suspects in the shooting, and small dark-colored vehicle was seen fleeing the area. Hughes, Alvarez, Brog, and Hommel were arrested and issued municipal citations for Disorderly Conduct and released from the station.

CASE SYNOPSIS

P.O. Sitter reports...

On 07/24/04 at 0220 hrs, Officers responded to a report of a fight and shots fired at Lenny's Tavern, 6309 W. National Ave. Upon our arrival, four parties, later identified as Willie O. Hughes, M/B, DOB 08/02/74, Annette M. Alvarez, F/W, DOB 12/06/76, Stacie L. Brog, F/W, DOB 03/17/75, and Erica L. Hommel, F/W, DOB 10/18/80, were discovered fighting in front of the tavern. Investigation later revealed that during the fight between Hughes, Alvarez, Brog, and Hommel, an unknown person appears to have fired four shots in the air while across the street from the tavern. There are no suspects in the shooting, and small dark-colored vehicle was seen fleeing the area. Hughes, Alvarez, Brog, and Hommel were arrested and issued municipal citations for Disorderly Conduct and released from the station.

ARRIVAL ON SCENE/OFFICER'S OBSERVATIONS

On 07/24/04 at 0220 hrs, Officers responded to a report of a fight and shots fired at Lenny's Tavern, 6309 W. National Ave. Upon my arrival, I observed a male party (later identified as Willie O. Hughes, M/B, DOB 08/02/74), and a female party (later identified as Stacie L. Brog, F/W, DOB 03/17/75), fighting on the sidewalk in front of the tavern. There were also a female party (later identified as Annette M. Alvarez, F/W, DOB 12/06/76), standing behind Hughes, and a female party (later identified as Erica L. Hommel, F/W, DOB 10/18/80), standing behind Brog. At the time, Alvarez and Hommel were not



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directly involved in the fight between Hughes and Brog, but were yelling loudly back and forth, causing a large disturbance in the middle of the sidewalk.

I was the first squad to arrive on scene, and observed Brog grabbing Hughes by the arm and yelling, "Hit me again! Go ahead, hit me again!" Brog threw herself on the ground, and tried to act like Hughes had just punched her or struck her somehow. All four parties, (Hughes, Alvarez, Brog, and Hommel) were yelling and screaming loudly at one another, and people were running in all directions as the disturbance continued. I separated Brog and Hughes, and began to investigate. Other Officers began arriving at that time as well, and began to speak with several reported witnesses to the incident.

STATEMENT OF COURTNEY NISSENBAUM-WITNESS

Officer Nelson reports...

I spoke with Nissenbaum at the scene. Nissenbaum was in the crosswalk on 63rd St. and W. National Ave. on the south side of the street. She observed several people in a physical altercation, on the sidewalk, in front of Lenny's, 6309 W. National Ave. One of the people involved in the altercation was a black male, identified as Willie Hughes. He was pushing a white female identified as Erika Hommel. He "pushed her into a car and threw her around like a rag doll."

During this incident she observed a small dark colored car, blue or black, stopped in 6300 block of W. National Ave. The vehicle was facing west, on the north side of the street. A person held a gun out of the front window and fired four or five shots. The vehicle immediately drove west on west National Ave. after firing the shots.

Nissenbaum was unable to identify any of the people in the vehicle, but was able to show me where the shot were fired. This is where I located the four shell casings in the roadway.

STATEMENT OF CHRISTOPHER LOEBER-WITNESS

Ptm Dunbar reports...

Sgt.Corwin observed a Cadillac, bearing WI registration # 206GHK, leaving the scene of Lenny's Tavern. He stopped the vehicle at 1200 S. 61 ST. I arrived to assist him. I spoke with Loeber. He stated that he was at Lenny's Tavern with his girlfriend, Deanna Miller. A friend of his, only known as Mike was leaving the bar, when a male black party jumped him.

Mike's girlfriend, tried to break up the fight, and the male black party hit her. Loeber stated that three other male white parties also started to fight with Mike. Loeber saw Mike's girlfriend get hit, so he tried to break up the fight. During the fight, the male black party knocked him to the ground.

Loeber stated that during the fight, he heard several gunshots being fired. He stated that he did not see who fired the gun, but observed several parties get into a smaller, gray vehicle and flee the scene west on W. National AV. Loeber described the vehicle as possible a 1990's model Honda or Hyundai.



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CONTACT STATEMENT / LEONARD E MALAN

Officer Wroblewski reports...

Reporting officer spoke with the owner of Lenny's Leonard E Malan regarding this incident. Malan stated that he had just started to close up when a group of 6 to 8 male/female black and Hispanics all in their mid to late 20's came into the bar. He stated that members in the group started flashing signs and exchanging words with some of the regular patrons in the bar. Malan stated that some of the regulars were leaving and the confrontation between the groups escalated as they went outside. Malan stated that the altercation carried over to the street out of the bar and he was able to close the bar door. He stated that he heard several shots from outside the bar but didn't know who fired the gun. Malan stated that Scott Jesion is a regular patron of his who had been involved in the confrontation inside the bar but he left via the back door of the bar when he heard the shots.

STATEMENT-WILLIE HUGHES AND ANNETTE ALVAREZ (OFFENDERS)

P.O. Sitter reports...

Upon my arrival, I separated Hughes and Brog from fighting, and Officers Kurtz and Fletcher spoke with Brog and Hommel while I spoke with Hughes and Alvarez. Hughes and Alvarez were very cooperative with me, and stated that Brog and Hommel were at fault in the fight/disturbance. Both Hughes and Alvarez had a strong odor of intoxicants on their breath and appeared intoxicated. They stated that they were just trying to leave the bar. They stated that they had just arrived at the bar a few minutes ago, and decided they didn't want to stay because of the type of crowd that was hanging out there.

Hughes and Alvarez stated that Hughes went to the bathroom, and that as they walked outside a few minutes later, Brog and Hommel began cursing and yelling at them for no apparent reason. They stated that Brog attacked Hughes, and that he had to knock a bottle of beer out of her hand to try and keep her away from him and Alvarez.

Hughes stated that he never assaulted Brog or Hommel, as they claimed, and was just trying to leave. Hughes and Alvarez did not wish to make separate statements, and were both placed under arrest for their loud disorderly actions when I arrived on scene. Both were handcuffed (safety-locked and checked for proper fit), transported back to the station, processed, and issued municipal citations for disorderly conduct. Both parties were cooperative and later released from the station.



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STATEMENT - STACIE BROG (OFFENDER)

Officer Kurtz Reports.....

Upon arrival, I spoke with Stacie L. Brog, who identified herself with a Wisconsin driver's license. Brog appeared angry and was yelling/swearing at two other people (Hughes & Alvarez). I asked her to walk with me away from these parties and she refused. I had to hold her arm and physically walk her away from the scene to cool down. She was breathing hard and crying.

I began to talk with Brog and she wanted her shoes and purse, which were on the sidewalk. She was advised that she could retrieve these items, but was not to yell or cause a disturbance again. Brog walked to her purse and began yelling and swearing at Hughes and Alvarez as they were talking with Officer Sitter. Officer Sitter placed Brog in handcuffs for safety reasons and placed her in the back of his squad.

A few minutes later, I spoke with Brog again. She was advised she was not under arrest at this time and I took the handcuffs off. Brog said that she did not know there was a fight inside of Lenny's Bar tonight. Everyone left the tavern when Hughes and Alvarez began to fight with her. Brog has never met these two parties before and she does not know why they were angry.

Either Hughes or Alvarez smashed a beer bottle over her head and she was punched several times by both parties. Brog fell to the ground at one point. She never punched anyone back, but she was yelling and swearing in the street. Brog was positive that it was Hughes and Alvarez that punched her and she wanted them arrested. Brog said that she observed Hughes push Hommel into a car. Brog heard several loud noises, but she did not know they were gunshots. She did not see anyone shoot a gun. Brog was not wearing shoes and her purse was on the sidewalk. Her jeans were ripped and her right hand had two broken fingernails and bloody knuckles. The right side of her cheek was swollen and she said her jaw was out of place. She did not want any medical treatment at this time.

I could smell a strong odor of ingested alcoholic beverage coming from her breath and she appeared intoxicated. Brog admitted to drinking alcohol tonight.

Brog was arrested for disorderly conduct and transported to the station by Officer Fletcher and I. She was cooperative the entire time, cited and released.

ON SCENE STATEMENT - ERICA HOMMEL (OFFENDER)

Officer Kurtz Reports.....

I spoke with Erica Hommel on scene. She identified herself with a Wisconsin driver's license. She calmed down after I made contact with her. Hommel said she was inside Lenny's Bar when a fight broke out. She observed several people fighting inside of the bar and beer bottles being thrown. The owner kicked everyone out of the bar. Once outside, she observed Hughes and Alvarez fighting with Brog. Hommel said that Hughes pushed her "Hard" one time just before officers arrived. Hommel asked Hughes to push her again when Officer Sitter arrived because she wanted the police to witness the push.



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Hommel heard four or five gunshots. She observed a vehicle parked directly across from Lenny's Bar. She believes the shooter was in this vehicle when he shot, but she did not see him. Hommel observed the vehicle leave west on National Ave. after the shooting. She could not give a description of the fleeing vehicle or the shooter. Hommel said that she was yelling and swearing outside of the tavern.

I could smell a strong odor of ingested alcoholic beverage coming from her breath and she appeared intoxicated. She admitted to drinking alcohol. Hommel admitted to yelling and swearing in the street. She was arrested for disorderly conduct and later transported into the station by Officer Fletcher and I.

STATEMENT OF ERICA L. HOMMEL-OFFENDER

P. O. R. Fletcher reports...

Upon arrival at the West Allis Police Department, I took off Hommel's handcuffs and placed her in interview room B. At approximately 0326hrs, I read Hommel her rights off of my department issued Miranda card. Hommel stated she understood these rights and wished to provide a statement. I asked her what had occurred tonight. Hommel was at Lenny's tavern with two acquaintances, Schaetzel and Brog. While they were in the tavern a fight broke out and two male parties broke a beer bottle over another individual's head. Hommel could not give a description of the parties with the bottle but she knows that the person struck by the bottle is Scott Jesion. At this point, the owner of the tavern told everyone to leave.

Hommel exited the bar and Borg was already outside. She did not see Schaetzel outside of the tavern. Brog was arguing with a black male, later identified as Hughes. They were yelling at one another but Hommel could not remember their exact words. According to Hommel, Hughes was in Borg's face. Hommel placed herself between Hughes and Brog. She gave the peace sign and told Hughes to "peace out". At this point, Alvarez approached the group and yelled, "Don't you disrespect my man." Hommel stated, "I'm not." Hommel again gave the peace sign and began yelling, "Peace, Peace."

Hughes grabbed Hommel by her arms and threw her to the ground. While on the ground, Hommel stated, "The cops are coming, why don't you do this for the cops." Hommel got to her feet and Hughes threw her to the ground again. While on the ground she heard what she believed to be gunshots. Hommel heard four shots and saw a car pullaway. She could not describe the car or the occupants of the car.

EVENSON REPORTS...

CONTACT WITH ZACHARY D. SCHNITZLER

While responding (E/B on W. National Ave.) to Lenny's tavern for a report of shots fired, I observed a M/W running N/B on S. 65 ST. from W. National Ave.. After stopping my squad car in the 1400 Blk of S. 65 St., I pointed my spotlight at the male and ordered him to stop running. The male immediately stopped running, turned towards me and placed his hands into the air while walking towards me. I placed him into handcuffs for my safety and asked him where he was coming from. The male, identified with a WI ID as Zachary D. Schnitzler stated that he had been exiting Lenny's when he observed an altercation between 2 females. While Zachary's attention was focused on the female's fighting, he heard an



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unknown number of gunshots ring out. Zachary stated that he fell to the ground briefly before rising to his feet.

Zachary stated that he did not see who fired the shots or if anyone had been hit. Zachary stated that he realized that he needed to get out of the area as soon as possible and began to run from the area. Zachary stated that he cut through a woman's yard and onto S. 65 St. before being stopped by police.

After Zachary consented to a search of his person, with no contraband located, he was released from the scene.

WITNESS STATEMENT / JENNIFER A. LUPO

After speaking with Zachary, I proceeded to the crime scene and assisted in securing it and speaking with witnesses. I was soon contacted by a neighbor who stated that she could have some useful information regarding the shooting. Jennifer A. Lupo, who resides in the rear residence at 6330 W. National Ave. stated that she was inside her home when she heard approx. 4 shots fired.

Immediately after hearing the shots, Lupo stated that she heard a vehicle speed E/B down her alley, which comes to a dead end behind her home. Lupo stated that after reaching the dead end, the vehicle stopped for approx. 30 seconds, at which time she looked out of the window and observed the vehicle, a small dark colored SUV, possibly a Tracker, then speed back W/B out of the alley and onto S. 65 St.. Lupo stated that the vehicle then drove back E/B on W. National Ave., past Lenny's and stopped briefly in front of McGuires Bar, 6235 W. National Ave., before continuing E/B on W. National Ave.. Lupo described the driver as a M/W having long, stringy blond hair and noted that an unknown front passenger was also inside the vehicle. A plate number of 992-BZY was obtained from the vehicle.

This plate (992-BZY) was found to list to Eric R. Racoma of 4228 S. 61 St. #3 Milwaukee, WI 53220. Checking Master Name, Racoma's DOB, 02/16/1965 was obtained.

PHOTOGRAPHS

Sergeant Corwin reports...

On 07/24/04 at approximately 0300hrs, I took several photographs in regards to a Weapons Offense that occurred in front of Lenny's Tavern, 6309 W. National Ave, (roadway).

I took the photographs with a department issued Canon Power Shot A70 Digital Camera SGT8. Below is the photo log Four spent shell casings were found in the roadway, (westbound lanes of W. National Ave), near light pole 6312 W. National Ave. Yellow lettered evidence markers, (A-D), were placed near the shell casing for documenting purposes.

Upon return to the station, the media card (SGT 8 B) on which the digital photos were stored, was secured in an envelope and placed in the ID Bureau locked storage drawer.

LOCATION OF SHELL CASINGS

Officer Nelson reports....

Our measurements of the shell casings were taken from light pole B2/6312 curb line and the sewer grate cover east of the Light pole. The distance between these stationary points was 21'8".

Shell casing "A" was 3'2" east of the light pole, on the curb line and 10'8" perpendicular from the curb line.

Shell casing "B" was 10'3" east of the light pole, on the curb line and 8'6" perpendicular from the curb line.

Shell casing "C" was 6'7" east of the light pole, on the curb line and 7'3" perpendicular from the curb line.

Shell casing "D" was 5'7" east of the light pole, on the curb line and 7'9" perpendicular from the curb line.

I placed the four .380 Auto. shell casings in separate paper bags and labeled them A-B-C-D. I placed them on West Allis Property # 28168, and locked them in locker #13.

CASE DISPOSITION

Hughes, Alvarez, Brog, and Hommel were all arrested, issued municipal citations for Disorderly Conduct, and released from the station.

Four .380 shell casings were recovered at the scene and placed on property# 28168 as evidence.

There are no suspects to the shooting incident at this time.

FOLLOW UP - TRAFFIC STOP

Officer Kurtz Reports....On 07-25-04 at approx.235 hrs. Officer Kempinski stopped a vehicle for speeding. Dennis W. Hess was driving the vehicle. He gave officers permission to search the vehicle. He was arrested for CCW (Large Hatchet). There were no firearms located. See I04-07569. The vehicle had Wisconsin registration #992-BZY, which was seen by a witness leaving Lenny's Bar at that the time of the shooting. I responded to the scene of the traffic stop and came into the station to interview Hess after he was arrested.

STATEMENT - DENNIS HESS (CONTACT)

While in interview #B in the booking room, I read Hess his Miranda warning from the card issued by the West Allis Police Department at approx. 0050 hrs. He said that he understood his rights and would answer questions without a lawyer present.

Hess said that he does not know how fast he was traveling when he was stopped. Hess said that he does not own the vehicle he was stopped in tonight. His business partner, Victoria, owns the vehicle, but he usually drives it. He has been driving the vehicle on a regular basis for several months and he knew the hatchet was hidden next to the driver's seat. Hess said that he gave Officer Kempinski permission to search the car and told her where the hatchet was located before she searched the vehicle. Hess said that Victoria has the hatchet in the vehicle for protection because she drives on the North side of Milwaukee. Hess does not believe he should be responsible for the hatchet because he does not own the vehicle.

I asked Hess if he was in the area of Lenny's Bar on 07-24-04 around bar close. Hess said he drove to his friend's house. His friend's name is Mike and he lives across from Lenny's Bar. Hess said he would not give me Mike's last name or any other information about him. He then said that he did not know anything else about Mike.

Hess was with his roommate, John Marotske. They were in the alley by Mike's house, when Hess did not see Mike's red car. Hess began to drive out of the alley when an unknown male told Hess that there was a shooting across the street a few seconds ago. Hess drove out onto National Ave. and observed many police cars in front of Lenny's Bar.

Hess drove past Lenny's Bar and parked a block away. He got out of his vehicle with Marotske and saw Officer Sitter. Marotske recognized Officer Sitter because he was arrested a few days ago. Hess listened to witness in the area talk with officers. Hess heard something about a fight and shooting. Hess said he stopped because he wanted to know what was going on in his neighborhood.

Hess and Marotske stayed in the area for 15 to 20 minutes and then drove to Maas gas station. They then drove home. Hess said that he did not shoot a gun that night and does not own any firearms. He has no personnel knowledge of the shooting. I told Hess that I wanted to talk with his roommate Marotske. Hess said that he knows for sure that Marotske is not home tonight. Hess was becoming angry with me and why he was being questioned.

I asked Hess if he was in the area of Lenny's Bar last night and he said "yes". (West Allis Police Department did receive an anonymous tip that the vehicle seen leaving the scene of the shooting was parked there again. Officers were not able to respond to that tip for two hour due to the amount of calls for service and the vehicle was gone.)

While talking with Hess, I asked Officer Dunbar to respond to his house and talk with Marotske. Hess found out later that officers went to his house and he became very angry. He was yelling/swearing in the booking room. He was very upset that I did not get his permission to send officers to his house. Hess was also angry that his vehicle was towed. The interview was ended at approx. 0120 hrs. and he was released.

CONTACT/STATEMENT OF JOHN J. MAROTSKE

Ptm Dunbar reports...

On 07/26/04 at approx. 0126 hrs, I spoke with John J. Marotske, M/W, 10/17/69, of 4220 S. 61 ST. #1, Hp# 329-0082, Cp# 232-7198. Marotske stated that he occasionally stays at 7010 W. National AV # 2, with his friend, Dennis Hess.

I asked him if he was with Hess on 07/24/04, at Lenny's Tavern. He stated that he was driving with Hess, and their friend, Victoria in her vehicle. They were driving to meet one of Hess's friends at an apartment building in the area of S. 65 ST./W. National AV. Hess's friend was not home, so they started to drive out of the alley behind the apartment building. While they were leaving, they saw a male white wearing a dark blue sweatshirt, walking in the alley. The male party had his hands in his pockets, and was trying to flag their vehicle down.

Marotske stated that there was another male party driving in a truck that told them that there was a shooting at Lenny's Tavern. They drove quickly out of the alley, to get away from the male party that was wearing the sweatshirt, because they thought that he might have a gun.

After they left the alley, they noticed a lot of squad cars, and a large group of people standing outside of Lenny's Tavern. Marotske stated that he stopped by McGuire's Tavern and spoke with some females that were standing on the corner and asked them what happened. After they talked to the females, they went back to 7010 W. National AV.

I asked Marotske if he would give me consent to search the apartment at 7010 W. National AV #2. He stated that he does not live there, so he did not feel that he could give me consent to search the apartment. He stated that Hess's mother also lives in the building, and she might have a key to the apartment.

I spoke with Hess's mother, Patty A. Liederbach, F/W, 02/05/54, 0f 7010 W. National AV # 1, Hp# 771-6156. She stated that she does not have a key to Hess's apartment, and would not give me consent to search his apartment.

08/17/04 at 1944 hrs Detective Kulinski reports...

On the above time and date, I made phone contact with Scott R Jesion, MW, 03/28/81. I asked him how the altercation in the bar began and what he could tell me about the people involved. Jesion stated that he was in the bar and got hit on the head with two bottles. He stated that he has no idea why the altercation began or why someone's attention was directed towards him. He stated that he received a swollen head but received no medical attention.

I asked what he knew about the people that were involved. He stated that he knew nothing. He stated that after he was hit, Lenny pushed him out the back door. He stated that he remembers someone in a blue car, but does not know what role they played in the situation. I then asked him about the gunshots. Jesion stated that he did not hear any gunshots and knows nothing about them.

Jesion stated that he would like to help me but has no idea who was involved in the alteration. At this time, there are no additional leads. This file should be considered inactive.

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

CASE SYNOPSIS

Pto. Sitter reports...

On 04/25/03 at 0004 hrs, Officers responded to a report of an assault at Lenny's Tavern, 6309 W. National Ave. Investigation revealed that Cheryl L. Zylka, and her boyfriend, Michael S. Abramowski, were involved in an argument inside the tavern, and Abramowski put out a cigarette on Zylka's forehead and struck her with a beer bottle. Zylka did not wish to pursue charges against Abramowski, who fled the scene prior to our arrival. Zylka was under 21 years of age and later mailed a citation for

Possessing/Consuming Alcoholic Beverages on Licensed Premise by Underage Person, and Abramowski was mailed a citation for Disorderly Conduct.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

Upon my arrival on scene, I observed a female party, (later identified as Cheryl L. Zylka, F/W, DOB 09/12/84) sitting at the bar with another female patron hugging her. Zylka was visibly upset and crying, and had dried blood around her nose. I observed a mark of some kind on her forehead, and the area below her right eye was bruised and swollen. I asked Zylka what happened, and she would not speak with me or tell me who assaulted her. I asked Zylka her name, but she wouldn't respond at first. After a few seconds, she stated, "Cheryl." I asked her if I could check her purse for her ID, and she stated that I could. As I checked Zylka's purse for identification, I discovered a WI photo driver's license belonging to a Margaret A. Stauff, F/W, DOB 04/30/80. I also discovered Zylka's license, next to Stauff's. West Allis Fire/Rescue# 2 arrived at the scene at that time, and began treating Zylka for her injuries. I was unable to speak with Zylka any further at that time, and she was transported to St. Luke's Medical Center for further treatment.

COMPLAINANT STATEMENT- LEONARD MALAN

While on scene, I spoke briefly with the owner/operator of the bar, Leonard Malan. Malan stated that he did not see the assault occur, but knew that the male party who Zylka came to the bar with struck her. Malan stated that prior to our arrival, Zylka and the male party she was with were involved in an argument. He stated that they went outside for a few minutes, and came back in together. Malan stated that just after walking back into the bar, the male party struck the female party as they sat at the bar. He stated that he did not actually see the male party strike her, but observed that Zylka had clearly been assaulted because of her injuries.

Malan stated that the male party began yelling at Zylka, creating even more of a disturbance inside the bar. He stated that he did not know what he yelled at her, but that he quickly fled the area before Officers were able to arrive on scene. Malan stated that he would be willing to testify against him in court for his disorderly conduct.

VICTIM/OFFENDER STATEMENT- CHERYL ZYLKA

After responding to St. Luke's, I spoke with Zylka about what happened at the bar. Zylka was very upset and reluctant at first, but then told me what happened. Zylka stated that she and her boyfriend, Michael Abramowski, came to the bar together and were drinking and talking. Zylka admitted that she used the ID that I discovered in her purse to purchase drinks at the bar, and that she knew the ID wasn't hers. Zylka stated that she was sorry, and stated that she knew she wasn't suppose to be in the bar or drinking.

Zylka stated that after she and Abramowski arrived at the bar, Abramowski started getting jealous that she didn't invite him to a movie that she went to with some friends of hers earlier in the day. She stated that Abramowski is always very jealous, and began accusing her of ignoring him. Zylka stated that they decided to go outside to talk about it. Zylka stated that while they were outside, Abramowski began telling her that he wanted to marry her, and that he wanted to ask her father's permission to ask her to marry him.

Zylka stated that she and Abramowski talked about things for a while, and went back in the bar. She stated that they sat down at the bar, and that Abramowski suddenly grabbed a cigarette, turned toward her, and put the burning end to her forehead. (I observed that there was a small round burn mark in the middle of Zylka's forehead as I spoke with her.) Zylka stated that she moved backward from the pain of the cigarette burning her, and that Abramowski grabbed a beer bottle and smashed her in the face with it. She stated that he struck her a second time, and the bottle broke as it hit her face. She stated that her face hurt, but she did not lose consciousness at any point during the assault.

Zylka stated that she and Abramowski have been together for approximately 10 months, but have never lived together, and do not have any children in common. Despite speaking with her at length, she refused to pursue charges against Abramowski in the matter. Zylka was still being treated for her injuries at the time, and I gave Zylka my business card if she decided to change her mind. It should be noted that Zylka also told me that a friend gave her the driver's license she used at the bar, but does not know where the friend got it from.

ARREST DECISION

Based on the fact that Zylka was under the legal drinking age and drinking in the bar, she was mailed a citation for Possession/Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages on a Licensed Premise, (M-79067). Due to the fact that Abramowski was disorderly and caused a disturbance in the bar by assaulting Zylka, he was mailed a citation for Disorderly Conduct, (M-79068).

EVIDENCE

At the station, I unsuccessfully checked numerous references in an attempt to contact the owner of the driver's license belonging to Margaret Stauff. In running Stauff though the DOT, her address shows 1802 Shepherd Ct. #215 in Waukesha. I was unable to find a current phone number for her with either the phone company or Waukesha P.D. In checking MasterName, the most recent contact with Stauff is from 10/08/000, and shows an address of 2627 N. Farwell Ave. #Upper, Milwaukee, WI 53221. I sealed the license in plastic and placed it on property, P# 25756.

CASE SYNOPSIS

Pto. T. Clementi report...

Officer Madden and I conducted random bar checks. We stopped at Lenny's Tavern (6309 W. National Av). Officers made contact with several parties in the bar checking identification. I made contact with a female party that verbally identified herself as Jenny Slivika. She stated she had left her identification at home, but assured officers that she was telling the truth. WAPD dispatch ran the name given through DOT and it came back as not on file. Investigation later revealed she had lied about her identity. She was identified as Breanne L. Hettich, F/W 04/02/83. She was arrested for being in a tavern underage and obstructing. She was transported to the station, mugged, printed and released with her citations.

INCIDENT

Off. Madden and I conducted a random bar check at several bars looking for any infractions including underage parties in the bar. We conducted a check at Lenny's bar and I made contact with an intoxicated female that verbally identified herself as Jenny A. Slivika, F/W 10/14/79 of 6508 Vista Ave. Wauwatosa 53213. She stated she had left her identification at home. Officers asked West Allis Dispatch to run DOT check on the name Jenny Slivika. We were informed that the name did not come back on file.

I confirmed the information with the female and asked dispatch to run the information again. The second request was also matched with the same fate not on file. I asked the female again if the information she had given was true and accurate. She told officers that was the correct information and began to get very upset. She yelled and swore at officers that we had no right to drag her out of the bar seeing as she had done nothing wrong. We explained to her that our concern was that she was lying and that she was not of age. She assured officers she was of age. I asked her again if she had a Wis. ID card or driver license. She said she had a Wis. ID at her home. I told her that if she had a Wis ID she would come back on file through DOT. Seeing as she did not come back on file we suspected her of giving false information. I explained to her that officers could drive her to her home and verify her identity with the ID she had at home.

After yelling again that we had no right to do what we were doing, she said she would go to her home to prove her identity. I transported her to her home at 6508 Vista Ave in Wauwatosa as Off. Madden followed. During that ride to the home I advised her that if she were found to be someone else she would receive a citation for obstructing an officer. I told her if she gave her correct name at that time she would avoid an Obstructing citation. She said again that she was not lying and she gave the correct information. Upon arriving at her house she was let out of the squad and we began to walk up to the rear door. As we got half way up the driveway she became very upset telling officers that they had no right to go into her home without a warrant. I tried to tell her that we were trying to get her ID as a courtesy. She became even more upset, loud and profane towards officers. Off. Madden observed some tension in the females body as she became upset and felt she was about to run away. Madden quickly grabbed the female and placed her in handcuffs escorting back to squad car.

Once she was securely placed in the squad car I attempted to make contact at the home, but no one answered. I did make contact with a female party one house to the north of 6508 Vista Ave. I asked if she knew the people that lived at 6508. She said she knew a dad lived there with his two daughters. I asked if she could identify a party I had in custody to see who she was and if she lived there. She said she would be able to if it was one of the daughters. I had the female I had in custody step from the car. The female immediately identified the party as Breanne Hettich.

As I was putting Breanne back into the squad car a younger female exited the house at 6508. She said she was Breanne's sister and also identified her as Breanne. The sister obtained a school ID of Breanne that contained her DOB as 04/02/83. I asked Breanne why she lied and she said it was not right what we were doing so she thought we should have to work for it. Breanne was transported to WAPD to be mugged, printed, issued citations and released.

While I transported her she was very obnoxious yelling to me that cops were wrong for what they did. They may think they are right when they do things, but they are all crooked. She said cops do more

illegal things than anyone else. During these statements they were laced with numerous profanities and derogatory terms for police officers.

BOOKING PROCESS

While I booked Breanne she became more calm. She had fewer mood swings and did not yell at officers as much. She still appeared to be very intoxicated, but it looked as if she was beginning to get tired. During this process Breanne stated she knew that she should not have been in the bar. I asked who's name had she given. She said it was from an ID she had found, but she had forgotten the birth date. Breanne said she had the ID card in the bar, but was never carded anyway. Breanne apologized for her behavior and said that she had just made the whole incident worse by lying.

CASE DISPOSITION

Breanne was cited for Obstructing an officers and consumption of alcohol underage on a licensed premise. A citation was also mailed to the owner/bartender that evening Lenny Malan on 11/01/02.
