

#### NARRATIVE

#### INITIAL CALL

Officers responded to 1503 S. 81 St. for a report of woman who had been punched in the face. Upon arrival, I observed the victim, Elizabeth Nelson, holding an ice pack to her face and her left eye appeared to be swollen. The offender was not on scene, so I spoke with the offender's boyfriend, Tom Giesegh.

#### STATEMENT OF TOM GIESEGH-WITNESS

According to Tom, his girlfriend Penny walked toward the bathroom where Elizabeth was sitting to show Elizabeth her new coat. Penny later alledged Elizabeth had intentionally ripped Penny's coat. Tom said Penny and Elizabeth then began to arque. From across the bar, Tom could hear Penny say "get your hands off my coat". Penny and Elizabeth separated, but continued to yell/argue from across the bar. Elizabeth said to Tom, "You want me to kick your girlfriend's ass?"

Elizabeth left the bar, so Penny followed her outside. Tom did not go outside, but later when Penny came back inside, she put her coat on and left. Penny

informed Tom that she had punched Elizabeth in the face and was going home to get ready to go to jail. The entire argument lasted about 15-20 minutes, and both Penny and Elizabeth had been drinking.

Tom called Penny and asked her to come back to the bar.

#### ON SCENE STATEMENT OF PENNY ALDERMANN-OFFENDER

Penny said she was showing off her new beaver fur coat and promise ring. Penny stated that Elizabeth grabbed the coat and says "there's a rip in it" and ripped a pre-existing hole even more. Penny said she asked Elizabeth why she would do such a thing, and asked if it was because Elizabeth was "stupid or vindictive". Penny said she was so upset she went to sit back down. Penny and Elizabeth were yelling at each other across the bar, and Penny said she would like to kick Elizabeth's ass. Penny could not remember how much she had to drink, but denies punching Elizabeth. Penny said she left the bar first.

#### OFFICER ACTIONS/OBSERVATIONS

Based on the victim and witness statements, I arrested Penny for battery and issued her a local citation. On 3/3/14 I observed the surveillance footage from the incident. At 2104 hrs, video shows Penny walk over by Elizabeth to show off her new ring and coat. Elizabeth is observed grabbing the coat to point out that there is a rip in it. It does not appear that Elizabeth rips the coat. Penny pulls the coat away and Elizabeth can be seen raising her arms and pulling away indicating she did not intentionally do any damage to the jacket.

Penny walks away, but at 2117 hrs, Penny confronts Elizabeth near the gaming machines and gets in her face. Penny starts yelling at Elizabeth who in turn starts yelling back. Penny walks away but they continue to exchange words. At approximately 2125 hrs Elizabeth walks out of the bar, and Penny immediately follows her. The door closes, but as it opens again Penny can be seen punching Elizabeth in the face at approximately 2127hrs. Penny then walks back in the bar, puts on her jacket, and walks northbound from the bar.

Prior to questioning, I read Penny her Miranda Rights off a WAPD standard form. Penny said she understood her rights and was willing to answer my questions without a lawyer present.

Penny said she was showing off her ring and fur coat worth \$2500. Penny said when she showed the coat to Elizabeth she said "There's a rip in it. This is nothing but a "Goodwill" jacket. This is so cheap". Penny said she was so shocked she went back to her seat to sit down. Penny said "Why would you do that? Are you that vindictive? You are an evil person for doing that". Penny was saying was how cheap Tom is, and that it's a "Goodwill" jacket.

Penny said they argued for a few minutes. She said she does not like to make a scene in a bar because she is also a bartender. She went outside about the same time as Elizabeth to have a cigarette. While outside, Elizabeth told her Tom was "a cheap motherfucker" and the jacket was a Goodwill jacket. Penny said she did not punch Elizabeth, and she must have got the mark from punching herself in the face because she is crazy. Penny said there were people outside when this happened, but was unsure how many. She does not know where those people went.

Penny said she was embarrassed for the argument and was leaving. She did not tell Tom she punched Elizabeth or that she was leaving because she was going to jail. Tom must have said that on scene because he was drunk. Tom and Elizabeth used to have a physical relationship. Penny never threatened to punch Elizabeth and Elizabeth never threatened her.

Penny was embarrassed because she got upset over the jacket. Penny said she took off the jacket to show it to Elizabeth. Elizabeth grabbed the jacket with two hands and ripped it. Penny said she went to sit down and did not immediately start arguing with Elizabeth.

#### NARRATIVE

#### INITIAL CALL

On 02/28/14 at 2129 hours, officers were dispatched to a fight at Capt'N Nicks bar at 1503 S 81 St. Upon my arrival at the bar, I was directed to speak to a witness inside the bar. The witness I spoke to identified herself verbally as Christi L. Stien, f/w, 05/19/82.

#### STIEN'S STATEMENT

Stien said she observed Elizabeth D. Nelson, f/w, 01/26/61 and Penny J. Alderman, f/w, 02/10/59 arguing inside the bar. At some point, Nelson decided to leave due to the escalating argument. Stien said she decided to then escort Nelson out of the bar. As Nelson and Stien were crossing the threshold of the entry/exit door, Alderman came up behind them and punched Nelson in the face twice. Alderman and Nelson continued to argue for a moment before the pair separated. A short time later, Alderman left the bar and the police arrived on scene. Officer Komorowski eventually placed Alderman under arrest and transported her to the West Allis Police Department.

#### INITIAL COMPLAINT

On 02/28/14, I responded to Capt'n Nicks, 1503 S 81 St, for an assault investigation.

### STATEMENT OF ELIZABETH D. NELSON

I made contact with Elizabeth D. Nelson, F/W 01/26/61, who stated she was assaulted by Penny J. Alderman, F/W 02/10/59. Penny had since fled the area, and most likely had walked to her apartment in the 1400BLK of S 81 St. Elizabeth advised Penny is currently dating her ex-boyfriend, "Tom."

According to Elizabeth, she got to the tavern on 02/28/14, at approximately 2000 hrs. Penny arrived at the tavern at approximately 2040 hrs, and walked up to Elizabeth to show off a ring and a fur coat she was wearing. Penny told Elizabeth she was engaged and Elizabeth congratulated her. As Elizabeth's friend walked up to them, Penny turned and Elizabeth noticed a rip on the shoulder area of her fur coat. Elizabeth pointed out the rip on Penny's coat, and Penny walked away to talk to Tom.

A short time later, Penny walked up to Elizabeth and pinched the back of her neck with her hand. She then accused Elizabeth of ripping her coat, which Elizabeth denied doing. Penny then walked into the bathroom but returned a short time later. She again grabbed the back of Elizabeth's neck and continued to accuse her of damaging her coat.

Penny walked away from Elizabeth but began to yell at her and call her names, which included, "Bitch, slut, and cunt." Elizabeth decided to finish her drink and leave the tavern, to avoid a possible altercation with Penny. As

with a closed fist. The punches occurred while on the sidewalk in front of the tavern, and Elizabeth told her she was calling the police. Penny then left on foot N/B, and most likely to her apartment in the 1400BLK of S 81 St.

Elizabeth denied damaging or ripping Penny's coat, and stated she did not hit, strike, or assault Penny in any manner. Elizabeth complained of pain to her face, and stated she wanted to pursue charges against Elizabeth for hitting her. I advised Elizabeth there were cameras in the tavern that would show whether or not she damaged Penny's coat, and that she could be arrested if that was the case. Elizabeth stated she understood, but was adamant she did not damage Penny's fur coat and the surveillance footage would prove it. She did admit she lightly touched the coat while Penny showed it off, but she did not rip it.

#### LACK OF CONSENT

Elizabeth did not give Penny consent to punch or assault her in any manner, causing her pain.

#### OFFICER OBSERVATIONS

I observed swelling and slight redness to the left side of the bridge of Elizabeth's nose, as well as under her left eye. She stated the swelling and redness was a result of Penny punching her, but she declined to have a rescue respond for her injuries.
