There were two additional incidents that occurred on June 24th and June 30th. These reports are in addition to the reports I submitted on July 2nd.

Incident reports:

Case # 12-005373, 06/24/2012, at approx. 0130 hrs – Wild Bill's Saloon, 1454 S. 92 St.

On 06/24/2012, at approx. 0130 hrs, Officers responded to Wild Bill's Saloon (1454 S. 92 St) for a report of 7-8 people actively fighting in the bar. Upon Officers arrival multiple persons were dispersed inside the bar. One of the individuals was very belligerent towards officers; he was subsequently arrested for Disorderly Conduct. All other parties were released without further incident.

Case # 12-005551, 06/30/2012, at approx. 0124 hrs – Barneks Tavern, 7411 W. Becher St.

On 06/30/2012, at approx. 0124 hrs, officers responded to Barnek's Tavern (7411 W. Becher St) for a report of a stabbing. Upon officers arrival contact was made with the victim who was bleeding profusely from the stomach region; the result of multiple stab wounds. The victim underwent emergency surgery at Froedert Hospital and is expected to survive. The stabbing appeared to due to the offender's extreme intoxication and delusional behavior.

During officers investigation it was revealed that there was a \$15.00 drug transaction (marijuana) that occurred in the bar between the offender and the victim. The actual stabbing took place directly outside the tavern.

In addition, the offender was drinking in the bar and is underage (20 years of age).

The offender was subsequently arrested by officers; he was charged by the Milwaukee County District Attorney with First Degree Reckless Injury, Use of A Dangerous Weapon and a Hate Crime.
