The first quarter of 2010 has been very busy for the School District's educational access channel.


They covered many sporting events; such as Central and Hale boys and girls basketball games, and the wrestling match between Central and Franklin at the WIAA State Tournament, but due to contractual rights with the WIAA they could only show highlights and not the entire match.

Other events included all three rounds of the Quiz Bowl, the District Spelling Bee, the Three to Get Ready program, the Blue Ribbon Celebration at Walker Elementary, and other school concerts.

Channel 13 continues to broadcast School Board meetings live and taped replays, along with live streaming of their programming on the internet.

It is staff's recommendation to continue the funding for the educational access channel operations.
