The following is a summary of reported incidents involving licensed businesses, including reported tavern violations and calls for police service during the month of February.

Incident reports:

Case # 13-001072, 02/04/2013, at 0220 hrs – Las Palmas Restaurant, 1901 S. 60 St.

On 02/04/2013 at 0220 hrs., Officers responded to Las Palmas, 1901 S. 60 St (unknown caller reported incident to police) for a Trouble Call. The caller reported someone was trying to break into Las Palmas and drove away in a red vehicle. Officers investigation revealed Jahir Tapia-Gasga struck the restaurant window several times. Jahir left the area with his friend in a red pick-up truck. Officers spoke with a customer, Daniel Delgado, at Las Palmas, who relayed he was involved in a physical altercation at bar close with Jahir. Both parties hit each other with a closed fist. Daniel wanted Jahir arrested. Officers arrested Jahir for Disorderly Conduct/Battery. The owner, Antonio Rivera, was on scene and was helpful to police, however, Officer Cato reminded him that he is required to call the West Allis Police Department any time Las Palmas Security has to break up a fight. Antonio stated he understood.

Case # 13-001530, 02/20/2013, at 0002 hrs – Jilly Bean, 9524 W. Greenfield Av.

On 02/20/2013 at 0002 hrs. Officers responded to Jilly Bean, 9524 W. Greenfield Av. (Unlicensed bartender called police) for a male causing problems. Investigation showed a highly intoxicated male was causing a disturbance inside and outside of the tavern. This male patron was yelling at a female and had left the bar. A short time later, he came back and attempted to get back into the bar. He was pulling at the front entrance door to the bar. Due to his behavior, the bar staff had to lock the door to prevent him from coming in. The party was placed under arrest for Disorderly Conduct and issued a Municipal Citation. While investigating this incident, it was discovered Rachael C. Tovar was bartending without a license. In addition, there was no

one inside Jilly Bean's that had a valid bartender's license. Eventually bar manager, Angela M Monigal, responded and she had a valid bartender's license through the City of West Allis. Rachael Tovar was issued a citation for Selling Alcoholic Beverages without a Class A License. The listed bar owner, John J. Biwer, was issued a citation for allowing an unlicensed person to operate a licensed premise w/o a licensed person on the premise. Officer made telephone contact with John. He stated he understood and had to further questions.

Tobacco and Alcohol Compliance checks:
