The Promotions Committee of the *Downtown West Allis Business Improvement District* has selected *Sunday, October 3, 2004, for our 14<sup>th</sup> Annual Classic Car Show*. Registration is held at 8:30 AM with the show beginning at 10:00 AM. Winning cars will be announced at 2:30 PM.

As in previous years, the BID requests the assistance from the City of West Allis for parking restrictions and the use of the following to ensure event safety:

- "No Parking" signs placed on Greenfield Avenue (north & south sides) from 70<sup>th</sup> to 76<sup>th</sup> Streets. Parking on Greenfield will be reserved for show entrants. Please deliver signs on Friday, October 1<sup>st</sup>. Signs will be turned to face the street on Sunday morning. Additional "No Parking" signs are needed for adjacent side streets: South 75<sup>th</sup> by City Hall, and north/south on 71<sup>st</sup>, 72<sup>nd</sup>, and 73<sup>rd</sup> Streets. We also ask that Public Works pick up signs on Monday, October 4<sup>th</sup>.
- Street closures and barricades on 71<sup>st</sup>, 72<sup>nd</sup>, and 73<sup>rd</sup> Streets, north and south, to create half-block areas for a live radio broadcast, pumpkin patch, special car displays, food areas, and additional car show parking.
- Additional police presence is requested in the area this day to discourage tire squealing and to monitor safety conditions. We invite the display of a Police vehicle and an Officer near 72<sup>nd</sup> and Greenfield Ave (north side).
- As with past Car shows, we ask for your assistance in providing eight stage flats for our music area on 72<sup>nd</sup> (south), use of three picnic tables for our food area, and benches to be used in a seating area.

The BID holds a one-million dollar event insurance policy with the City of West Allis listed as an additional insured (see attached).

The BID thanks Mayor Bell and the Common Council for their continued support. Further thanks to Public Works and the Police Department for their services. If you have any questions, call the BID office at 774-2676.
