The following is a summary of reported incidents involving licensed businesses, including reported tavern violations and calls for police service during the month of April.

Incident reports:

Case # 14-2302, 03/18/2014, at 0146 hrs – 1309 S. 60 St. – Remedy (was not reported in March Tavern Report)

On 03/18/2014 at approximately 0146 hrs., Officers responded to 1309 S. 60 St, Remedy, for a trouble call. The victim was punched in the face several times by an unidentified offender. The victim, who was intoxicated, stated he was assaulted after he asked two males to leave the tavern. These males were causing a disturbance in the bar.

Case # 14-2780, 04/03/2014, at 0111 hrs - 9440 W. National Av. - Brooklyn's

On 04/03/2014 at approximately 0111 hrs., Officers responded to 9440 W. National Av, Brooklyn's, for a trouble call. A patron was unable to pay for a private dance and proceeded to create a disturbance inside the business with staff. The patron was arrested, booked and cited for Disorderly Conduct and Fraud.

Case # 14-3075, 04/11/2014, at 2015 hrs – 9300 W. National Av. – Jbeans

On 04/11/2014 between 1740 hrs and 2015 hrs a white male used a \$20.00 bill, with fishing line taped to it, to pull his money out of the gambling machines at 9033 W. National Av., JBeans, allowing him to play the machines for free and collect money from the tavern. The tavern owner estimates the male collected approximately \$1,500.00 from the tavern.

Case # 14-3188, 04/15/2014, at 2335 hrs – 1430 S 81 St – Paulie's Field Trip

On 04/15/2014, at 2335 hrs., Officers responded to 1430 S. 81 St., Paulie's Field Trip for a male throwing bar stools at the bartender and patrons. The Offender refused to pay his bar tab, became enraged and began to throwing barstools. He was arrested and issued two citations for Disorderly Conduct, Criminal Damage to Property and Fraud on Tavern.

Case # 14-3439, 04/24/2014, at 1830 hrs - 5632 W. Burnham St - 57 Bar

On 04/24/2014, at 1830 hrs., Officers responded to 5632 W. Burnham St, 57 Bar, for an assault. The bartender was working when her roommate showed up. She asked him to leave, which he did, but returned later. She advised he is not supposed to be at the bar, as he has caused problems with her in the past. She went outside and had him come out with her. Once outside, a physical altercation ensued. The Officer noted she detected a strong odor of intoxicating beverages emitting from the bartender. The roommate was arrested for Battery.



INITIAL CALL

Officer Mathy reports...

On 03/18/14 at approximately 0146hrs, I responded to the Remedy bar, 1307 S. 60 St., for a trouble call. Dispatch advised a male party was assaulted in the bar and the offenders reportedly fled the scene.

INITIAL CONTACT- JOHN P. MOEBS (VICTIM)

Upon arrival I made brief contact with the victim, John P. Moebs M/W 04/29/81, who stated he did not want medical attention. Moebs, who had a superficial laceration above his left eye, as well as swelling around the orbital area, stated he was assaulted by two males after he requested them to leave. Moebs was intoxicated as his speech was slurred, his eyes were red and glassy, and he had a moderate odor of intoxicants emitting from his breath. Prior to having Moebs describe the incident I asked him to describe the offender. Moebs said he had limited information and a witness, Laticia Y. Kaufmann F/W 08/23/76, stated she observed the incident and can describe the offenders.

STATEMENT- LATICIA Y. KAUFMANN (WITNESSS)

I asked Kaufmann to briefly explain the incident and describe the individuals Kaufmann said Moebs was assaulted after he asked to males to leave the bar for the evening. Kaufmann said both individuals involved were causing a disturbance in the bar and also harassing other customers who had since left. asked Kaufmann to describe the two individuals that assaulted Moebs. Kaufmann said the male that struck Moebs several times was a white male, approximately mid 20's in age, 5'10, 170lbs, with shoulder length red/ blonde hair, a light colored beard extending approximately 3-4 inches from his chin, wearing a long sleeve green sheet and denim pants. Kaufmann said the aforementioned offender was accompanied by another male, described as a white male, early 20's in age, approximately 5'11, 165 lbs, with a short buzz cut hair style and no facial hair. I immediately radioed responding squads the suspect descriptions and asked Kaufmann to explain what occurred.

Kaufmann stated she observed both indviduals she described inside the bar when she arrived to start her cleaning shift. Kaufmann said she believed both parties were intoxicated due to their boisterous behavior and loud profane language. Kaufmann said prior to Moebs being struck, the male with the long hair and beard told a customer "I'll fuck you up." Kaufmann said the customer who was told that left immediately after being confronted by the suspect. Kaufmann said shortly after the suspect threatened the un-identified customer that the suspect punched Moebs several times in the head. I asked Kaufmann to explain what events took place leading to Moebs being struck. Kaufmann said Moebs, who is friends with the bartender, Tina L. Flynn F/W 08/21/70, asked the suspect with the beard to leave the bar after he yelled at the un-identified customer. Kaufmann said Fynn yelled at the suspects to leave and that was when Moebs told them they should leave. Immediately after Moebs told the suspects to leave, the male in the beard approached Moebs striking him in the face several times.

Kaufmann said Moebs fell down during the altercation and stated the male with the beard was the predominant aggressor. Kaufmann said the other male she described with the shaved head was also involved in the confrontation, however, she could not specify if he struck Moebs. Kaufmann said the male with the shaved head was

directly next to the aforementioned suspect, as well as Moebs, during the confrontation. Kaufmann said that Moebs did not threaten or strike either suspect at any time. Kaufmann then presented me with a knit red and black hat which had a "G" on the front of it and stated the offender with the beard was wearing the hat prior to the altercation. I asked Kaufmann if she believes she would be able to identify the offender in a photo lineup and she said she is confident she could.

STATEMENT- JOHN P. MOEBS (VICTIM)

After speaking with Kaufmann I made contact with the victim, Moebs, and asked him to explain what occurred. Moebs said he asked two white males, who were approximately in their mid 20's, to leave the bar after they became profane. Moebs said he was immediately approached by one of the male's, who he described as having long hair and a beard, and he was punched several times. Moebs said he believes he was also punched by the other white male, who he described as having a bald head, however, Moebs said he was attempting to cover his face and could not distinguish how many times he was struck. Moebs said he lost his glasses during the confrontation and said he did not attempt to hit either of the males. Moebs said the assault was unprovoked and that he has not seen either of the individuals before.

It was apparent that Moebs was intoxicated as his speech was slurred, his eyes were red and glassy, and he had a moderate odor of intoxicants emitting from his breath. Moebs said he was confident that he would be able to identify the offenders in a photo lineup. Moebs said he did want both offenders arrested for punching him. I asked Moebs again if he would like and ambulance or medical assistance and he refused.

LACK OF CONSENT

Moebs did not give anyone permission to punch him, causing him pain and injury.

INJURIES

As a result of the assault, Moebs received various superficial injuries. Moebs left eye was slightly swollen and red. Further, there were two superficial lacerations directly above and below Moebs left eye which were approximately one inch in length.

STATEMENT- TINA L. FLYNN (WITNESS)

After speaking with Moebs about the incident, I asked the bartender, Flynn, if she could describe what happened. Flynn provided a similar description of both offenders and stated they were both becoming hostile toward the bar close. Flynn said she yelled at the offenders to leave the bar after they yelled at a different customer, who left prior to Officers arrival. Flynn said she did not see Moebs

get punched, however, she heard the disturbance and is confident she could identify both offenders.

I asked Flynn if she had access to video surveillance and she said she did not. Flynn provided me with her manager's name, only known as Angie, and provided me with her phone number. Flynn believed the incident would be on video and said Angie is familiar with the software. Flynn did not have any other pertinent information to add concerning the incident.

I placed the digital media card into a secured drawer in the Forensic/Technical Services Bureau.

PROPERTY

While on scene I seized the aforementioned knit red and black hat, which was worn by the offender prior to the assault, and placed it on property number 14-001831-1.

FOLLOW UP

I attempted to contact Angie several times via phone following the incident. I left several voicemail messages on Angie's cell phone, 414-350-5991, as well as at the Remedy bar, for Angie to contact me in regards to the video surveillance. On 03/21 Angie left a voicemail for me at the WAPD stating she was unable to burn a copy of the video. Angie requested that an IT specialist from the WAPD respond to the bar to access the video. As of 03/28/14, I have been unable to speak with Angie on the phone.

CASE DISPOSITION

At this time neither of the two suspects have been identified. Investigation is


Officer Mathy reports...

CALL FOR SERVICE

On 04/03/14 at approximately 0111 hrs, officers responded to a trouble call at Brooklyn's, 9440 W. National Ave. Dispatch advised a patron, later identified as Ryan D. Soto (m/w, 08/14/90), was creating a disturbance inside the establishment and fighting with security.

STATEMENT - TODD E. KOHLER

SEE OFFICER SCHNEIDER'S SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT

STATEMENT - RYAN D. SOTO

I arrived on scene and a party later identified by WI DL as Soto was standing outside with security employee, Todd E. Kohler $(m/w,\ 02/02/65)$. I was informed Soto was the subject creating the disturbance, and Soto was placed in handcuffs to prevent further incident.

I asked Soto what happened inside Brooklyn's, and he stated he paid \$140 for a private dance, but was dissatisfied with the length of the dance. Soto advised the songs for each dance were cut in half, and did not feel he received what he paid for. I informed Soto the complaint came in stating he had not yet paid for

the dance, and Soto advised he had not. Soto stated he did not feel as though he needed to pay for the dance because it was not what he expected.

While speaking with Soto, I detected a strong odor of intoxicants emitting from his breath, slurred speech, and red and glassy eyes. Soto admitted he had consumed an unknown amount of intoxicating beverages prior to the incident inside Brooklyn's. I attempted to ask Soto further questions as it pertained to the incident, but due to his impaired stated, I was unable to obtain further information.

LACK OF CONSENT

Brooklyn's did not consent for Soto to refuse payment for the private dance he received and attempt to leave without paying.

ARREST DECISION

Based on the statements obtained by officers on scene, the decision was made to arrest Soto for disorderly conduct and fraud on the business. Soto was subsequently transported to the West Allis Police Department for processing.

BOOKING

Soto was booked under #14-001567 for WA-947.01 Disorderly Conduct and WA-943.21(1)(a) Fraud on Hotel/Restaurant Keeper/Taxi.

During the booking process, I informed Soto I would be reading him his Miranda Warnings, which he stated he had nothing further to say.

CASE DISPOSITION

Soto was issued municipal citation M140015671 for WA-947.01 and municipal citation M140015672 for WA-943.21(1)(a). Soto signed each court copy and received offender copies of each corresponding citation. Soto's local court date is scheduled for 05/12/14 at 0830 hrs. Soto was later released without incident.

Kohler chased after Soto and grabbed him as he ran down the stairs. Kohler stated Soto turned around and punched him in the face, causing pain. Kohler grabbed Soto and wrestled with him. 

NARRATIVE

INITIAL RESPONSE

On 04/12/14 at approximately 1109 hours I responded to 9033 W. National Ave. for a theft report. Upon arrival I spoke with Jason J. Powelski.

STATEMENT FROM JASON J. POWELSKI

Jason J. Powelski is the owner of 9033 W. National Ave.

Powelski said on 04/11/14 between 1740 hours and 2015 hours a white male used a \$20.00 bill with fishing line taped to it to pull his money out of the gambling machines allowing him to play the machines for free and collect money from the tavern. Powelski cashed out the machines on 04/12/14 and found a \$20.00 bill with suspicious tape design on it. Powelski reviewed the video footage from the night before and observed a male pulling his money out of the machine by a fishing line after it was accepted and registered.

Powelski explained once someone wins on the machines a receipt prints out behind the bar and the bar tender pays the winnings and signs the receipt. The receipts do not list the name of the person who won and only list values paid. Powelski said the business keeps a \$2000.00 reserve behind the bar for the machines and \$400.00 was left. Powelski estimates the male collected approximately \$1500.00 from the tavern.

Powelski advised he would need more time to determine the exact amount of money the offender received after playing the machines for free.

OFFENDER DESCRIPTION

Powelski showed me a VHS black and white video surveillance recording of the offender playing the machines. The offender would submit two bills into the machine then pull on a very thin wire and retrieve the money. The offender would then play the machine and appear to walk to the bar.

The offender is described as a white male, approximately 40 years of age, heavy build, bald with hair around the side of his head and light facial hair. The offender appeared to be wearing checkered shorts with a t-shirt with a stripe and "88" printed on it.

LACK OF CONSENT

Powelski did not give anyone permission to play the gambling machines for free and collect money for fraudulent winnings.

PROPERTY

Powelski turned over the \$20.00 bill he found in the machine. The bill had scotch tape down the front center and along the sides. The \$20.00 bill had serial number AH00677020C and routing number H8. The \$20.00 bill was placed on property under property number 14-002452-1.

CASE DISPOSITION

Powelski was given my information and advised to call the police if the offender returns.

She advised that on 04/11/14 she was working and paid out the suspect several times.

Liwoski advised that they had five gambling machines in the bar and two of them were actually owned by the bar. She advised that the other three are leased and registered with the City of West Allis. Liwoski described the machines as 1-5, from west to east. She advised that machines 2 and 3 are owner by the bar and machines 1,4 and 5 are leased. Liwoski believed that the theft from 04/11/14 was from gambling machine 2 and 3.

Liwoski advised that on 04/15/14 another two male suspects were inside the tavern and observed with a line attached to a twenty dollar bill. They fled the tavern in a vehicle with Illinois license plates. She advised that these suspects had a southern accent. Liwoski believes that the suspect from 04/11/14 was able to steal approximately \$2,000 to \$3,000. She said that he was able to remove money from the machines and cashed out several times with the bar.

Liwoski admitted that an envelope is kept behind the bar, containing money for the gambling machine payout. I advised Liwoski of the concerns with this investigation. Liwoski was understanding and advised that she would be cooperative with the investigation.

I asked the Collier where the gambling machine payout envelope was kept. She advised that it was in the drawer adjacent to the cash register. Collier accessed the drawer and provided me with the bank envelope labeled "Machines and Pull Tabs Only". Collier added that there is always a total of \$1,000 in the bag. She said that she made several pay outs already today, so whatever cash is left can be cross referenced with the receipts for pay outs. At this time I seized the bank bag containing \$606 (30-\$20's, 1-\$5 and 1-\$1), three pulls tabs, five payout receipts and gambling ledgers.

Photographs of the gambling machines and the seized bank bag were taken on scene. After leaving JBeans I contacted Powelski regarding this investigation. Powelski was very cooperative and understanding. I advised him that I would be issuing him a municipal citation # M100058 for the offense. Powelski agreed to meet once back from vacation on 04/28/14.


Money Disposition

She advised that Nunnemacher follows her around and that must be how he knew where she was there. Burk was not sure of the exact time, but thought that Nunnemacher showed up at around 1800 Hrs. Burk advised she had asked Nunnemacher to leave. Burk stated that Nunnemacher was saying "I wish you were a skank like your sister."

Burk stated that approximately three hours later Nunnemacher returned. Burk advised that Nunnemacher is not really supposed to be at the bar as he has caused problems with her in the past. She stated this time when he came back she was done working. Burk stated that Nunnemacher was

calling her a skanky bitch and a whore. She went outside and had him come out with her. Burk stated once outside, Nunnemacher grabbed her by the shirt. He tried to pull her in the direction of his van. Burk stated she was trying to get his hand off of her shirt by hitting him. Nunnemacher grabbed Burk by the face and squeezed it.

Burk stated this whole situation scared her and caused her to fear for her safety.

Through out my contact with Burk I detected a strong odor of intoxicating beverages. She had red glassy eyes and slurred speech. I believed her to be under the influence of an intoxicant.

Burk became upset with me as I was trying to tell her to respond to the D.A. Office for charging. She stated we never help her.

Lack of consent...

Burk did not give Nunnemacher consent to grab her shirt, her face, cause her pain, cause her to fear for her safety.

Nunnemacher stated he went to pick Burk from work. He advised he arrived around 1500 Hrs. and that Burk had been drinking. Nunnemacher stated that Burk was drunk and out of hand. He advised when she started talking crazy he decided he was not going to take her home. Nunnemacher stated Burk said she was going to call the cops and tell them he was touching her. Nunnemacher said he was going to leave and Burk grabbed him by the coat and slapped him in the chest. Nunnemacher got in his van and left, but not before telling Burk to text him an address to have her belongings shipped to.

Nunnemacher advised he would not come into the station and that he would not go to the D.A. charging. He stated he would have an attorney respond on his behalf sometime during the day.

Nunnemacher had no further information regarding this incident.

INITIAL COMPLAINT

On 04/24/14, at 1856 hrs, Officer Kielley and I responded to the 57 Bar, 5632 W Burnham St, for an assault. Investigation revealed a female subject, later identified as Ezra R. Burk, F/W 12/31/74, was assaulted by a male subject, later identified as Harry A. Nunnemacher, M/W 04/11/58, who fled prior to our arrival.

STATEMENT OF RONALD W. KLEIN

While on scene, I made contact with a witness, Ronald W. Klein, M/W 02/25/58, who witnessed part of the altercation. Klein stated he was sitting at the bar between a female subject and a male subject, who were later identified as Burk and Nunnemacher. Nunnemacher approached Burk and began talking to her. However, Klein does not know what the nature of the conversation was regarding, as he was not paying much attention to them. Klein did hear Burk telling Nunnemacher that she did not have anything to say to him and she did not want him talking to her.

Klein stated Burk exited the bar a short time later, and Nunnemacher followed her outside. Klein left the bar for a cigarette break and noticed Burk and Nunnemacher talking in the parking lot for the business. Klein heard Nunnemacher tell Burk that he was going to have her evicted, and that "Eagle movers" would remove her belongings from the residence. Burk responded by telling Nunnemacher she was on the lease and not going to leave, and they continued talking to one another.

During their interaction outside, Klein observed Nunnemacher push Burk with both of his hands, causing her to stumble backwards. Burk told Nunnemacher



STATEMENT OF OFFENDER - BRENT ALEXANDER

I attempted to speak with Alexander as he was placed into the back of my squad. Alexander stated he was an original gangster and that he would fight anyone that was around. Alexander denied any physical fighting inside of the business with anyone. Alexander stated he had no knowledge of anything being broken inside of the bar. While I was speaking with Alexander, I detected a strong odor of intoxicants emitting from his breath. I noticed his eyes were red and glassy and he slurred his speech as he spoke to me. Based upon these observations I believed Alexander was highly intoxicated.

Based upon Alexander's statement of being pepper sprayed by a patron in the bar, I had WAFD respond to complete a fluid flush. Alexander was highly uncooperative with officers and was screaming outside of the squad. Alexander's face was cleaned and he was placed back into the squad. As Alexander was being transported to the main station, he would kick the sides of the rear cage of my squad. Alexander was screaming and yelling about physically fighting with police officers and that he was a gangster from Los Angeles. Alexander had to be placed in a cell prior to the booking process based upon his uncooperative behavior.

ON SCENE STATEMENT OF JOHN M. SUTTON (VICTIM)

John reported earlier in the night, a black male, later identified as Brent A. Alexander (M/B 05-06-71), and his unidentified associate entered the bar and started a tab. At approximately 2315 hours, Brent started walking out of the bar. John informed Brent that he needed to pay his bar tab, which was approximately \$50.00. John informed me that Brent was intoxicated and became belligerent when informed about his tab. Brent questioned how John could just punch some buttons on the register and come up with \$50.00. Brent refused to pay his bar tab, which equaled \$54.50.

John stated after the person that Brent came into the bar with told Brent to pay his tab, Brent got even more upset and shoved the unidentified male onto the ground. Brent proceeded to pick up a bar stool and throw it at the John. John ducked and avoided being struck by the stool. Brent then picked up another bar stool and threw at another patron of the bar.

Fearing for his safety and the safety of the other patrons in the bar, John took the pepper spray, which was located behind the bar, and sprayed Brent with it and then immediately called 911. As John called 911, other patrons prevented Brent from leaving until officers arrived. John stated the pepper
