RE: City Attorney's Report of Claim

Dear Council Members:

The enclosed claim has been referred to this office in accordance with Section 3.05 (6)(a) of the Revised Municipal Code. This office has examined the facts of the claim and the applicable law. Our Opinion regarding liability is as follows:

**It is the recommendation of this office that the following claim be denied:**

**Georgia T. Sullivan - Amount: \$2,317.13**

This is a claim for damages sustained to the claimant's vehicle on March 12<sup>th</sup>, 2008, when the claimant was involved in an accident with a City of West Allis fire truck in front of Fire Station No. 1 located at 7332 West National Avenue, West Allis, WI. At said time and place, the operator of the fire truck was positioned in the parking lane of westbound traffic on National Avenue waiting for traffic to clear so that he could back the truck up into the fire station. Once westbound traffic totally cleared, the operator pulled out into the westbound lane now totally blocking it with his emergency lights in full operation. Approximately 10 seconds later, when traffic in the eastbound lane cleared, the operator pulled forward into the eastbound lane now blocking all of National Avenue to begin his routine back up procedure when he was struck by the claimant's vehicle heading westbound on National Avenue but located in the east lane of National Avenue at the time of the collision as the claimant attempted to get around the fire truck. The claimant obtained two (2) estimates for repair to her vehicle as a result of the accident and filed a claim against the City on March 27<sup>th</sup>, 2008.

Our investigation into this claim indicated that the claimant was more negligent in this accident than the operator of the fire truck. According to the fireman's testimony, the fire truck was positioned in a manner totally blocking westbound traffic on National Avenue with its emergency lights in full operation for approximately 10 seconds before the collision. Because the claimant was heading in a westerly direction, there is simply no way that the claimant would not have seen the fire truck blocking the lane with its emergency lights on. The siren on the fire truck was not on because it is not the Fire Department's policy to activate sirens when backing rigs into the fire station. Regardless of, the claimant should have seen the fire truck and reduced her speed appropriately or came to a complete stop to allow the fire truck ample time to get out of the westbound lane as opposed to the claimant's actions of entering the eastbound lane to get around the fire truck. The claimant was negligent for not keeping a proper look out in this case and is trying to shift the blame to the Fire Department for her inattentive driving on the day of the accident.

Based upon the above, it is the recommendation of the City Attorney's Office to deny this claim pursuant to the provisions of Wisconsin Municipal Claims Statute 893.80.

At its meeting on June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2008, the Common Council of the City of West Allis considered your claim received on April 7<sup>th</sup>, 2008, regarding vehicle damage allegedly sustained at 7332 West National Avenue, West Allis, Wisconsin and denied it in full.
