- (c) The exception allowed in subsection 5.10(9)(b)3 shall not apply during such times as the West Allis Fire Chief declares a ban on burning due to dry conditions. Notice of such ban shall be published in the official City newspaper. After publication or after direct notice, no person shall use such a devise until the West Allis Fire Chief declares that the ban is terminated.
- (d) The burning permitted in subsection 5.10(9)(b)3 shall be subject to the following conditions:
- 1. Such devices shall not be used on porches or decks or within ten (10) feet of a dwelling, garage, or other accessory structure.

- 2. Such devices shall not be used between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.
- 3. Such devices shall be tended by a competent person at all times combustion is occurring. To constitute being "tended," the device must be within the direct observation of the competent person taking care of the fire.

PART II. All ordinances or parts of ordinances contravening the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

PART III. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND RECREATE SUBSECTION 5.10(9) OF THE REVISED MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO OPEN BURNING

The Common Council of the City of West Allis do ordain as follows:

PART I. Subsection 5.10(9) of the Revised Municipal Code is repealed and recreated to read:

5.10 FIRE PREVENTION CODE.

* * *

- (9) Open Burning.
- (a) For purposes of this subsection, "open burning" means oxidation from which the products of combustion are emitted directly into the ambient air without passing through a stack or chimney.
- (b) Except as provided herein, open burning is prohibited in the City of West Allis and no person, firm, corporation or other entity shall burn, cause to be burned, or suffer or allow to burn in the open air leaves, garden refuse, wood, refuse, or other combustible material.
 - (c) This subsection shall not apply to:
 - 1. A charcoal or gas grill used in the cooking of food.
 - 2. The smoking of tobacco products.
 - 3. A device for the burning of wood similar in construction to charcoal and gas grills that is equipped with a metal hood and screen that completely encloses the area where wood is burned so as to prevent embers or sparks from exiting the device. Such device shall have a base no larger than eight (8) square feet and a volume no larger than (24) twenty-four cubic feet.
- (d) The exception allowed in subsection 5.10(9)(c)3 shall not apply during such times as the West Allis Fire Chief declares a ban on burning due to dry conditions. Notice of such ban shall be published in the official City newspaper. After publication or after direct notice, no person shall use such a devise until the West Allis Fire Chief declares that the ban is terminated.

ENACTED ORDINANCE

Please take notice that the City of West Allis enacted Ordinance No. O-2000-0002, Ordinance to Repeal and Recreate Subsection 5.10(9) of the West Allis Revised Municipal Code Relating to Open Burning, on June 4, 2010. The ordinance addresses allowing a device for burning of wood that is equipped with a metal hood and screen that completely encloses the area where the wood is burned and certain conditions which permit the burning in such a device.
