1. REVIEW OF NEW LEGISLATION

AB649 PROHIBITS PLACING RENTERS' UTILITY DELINQUENCIES

ON LANDLORD'S PROPERTY TAXES

OPPOSE, because the bill would make it almost impossible for the City to collect

delinquent utility charges.
