December 3, 2014	Fire	While leaving a training exercise at a City owned building located on the SW corner of S 56 St and W Walker St, T2 turned at the intersection and the rear hand rail contacted a vehicle that was parked near the intersection. Investigation revealed that an illegally parked vehicle (not the vehicle that was struck) had forced T2 to make a tighter turn than should have been necessary. Damage to T2 was minimal. Damage to the struck vehicle was moderate. There were no injuries to Fire Department personnel or civilians.	No discipline was administered due to the fact that an illegally parked vehicle had been a significant contributing factor to this incident. All personnel involved were required to review Department Policy 3.01 regarding operation of fire department apparatus in tight spaces.
