

I spoke with Kyle who stated he arrived at Dopps Bar at approximately 2030 hrs, to hangout with some of his family. He told me he was playing Jenga, when a bald M/W, wearing a black leather jacket began pushing his cousin Ronald. Kyle advised me he ran over to Ronald's location to try and stop the altercation.

Once Kyle stepped in between his cousin and the male, he was punched 3 or 4 times in the face. The owner Tammy Dopp, broke the fight up, and Kyle and Ronald left the bar soon after. I asked Kyle where Ronald was and he replied, "I don't know, he must have left." I asked Kyle to call his cousin and have him return to the bar so officers could speak with him, but Ronald did not answer his phone.

Based on multiple witness statements that Kyle and Ronald were the ones that initiated the fights, they were arrested for Disorderly Conduct. Kyle was handcuffed, searched, and placed in my squad car to be transported back to the station for the booking process.

**BOOKING**

Kyle Robinson was booked under WAPD Booking #2013005729, for Disorderly Conduct. He was issued local citation M130057291, and released.

Ronald Frakes was booked out of custody under WAPD Booking #2013005769, for Disorderly Conduct. He was mailed local citation M130057691.

**CUSTODIAL INTERVIEW**

On 12/11/13 at approximately 0020hrs, while in Interview Room B of the West Allis Police Department, I read Kyle Robinson his Miranda Warning per WAPD Directive 42.016. Kyle stated that he understood his rights and was willing to make a statement or answer questions about this incident. The following is a brief synopsis of that interview, which was recorded using WAPD Audio Recorder and Media Card P15-2.

Kyle restated what he told me on scene. I asked him about the second fight that broke out and why he did not tell me about it. He did not have a response. Kyle advised me after the first fight was over, the bartender told him and Ronnie, (Ronald), to leave, and they began to pack up their property.

As they were walking out, Ronald began talking trash to the people they were just fighting, and a second fight broke out. As he was standing by the front door a male ran up and began throwing punches at him. Kyle began throwing punches back, but was backed into the corner. It is at this point where he sustained the small laceration above his left eye. Kyle stated he doesn't remember much about the fight, but remembers yelling, "Stop!" After the fight he grabbed his pool stick and walked out the back door.

**NARRATIVE**

Officer Tuschl reports...

INITIAL RESPONSE/OBSERVATIONS

On 12/10/13 at about 2328hrs I responded to Dopp's, located at 1753 S. 68th St for a large bar fight. While en route to the call, W.A.P.D Dispatch advised there was ten to fifteen people fighting inside the bar. Once I arrived on scene I observed a M/W (later identified as Kyle D. Robinson M/W 05/02/91) exit the bar through the main entrance door and start to walk N/B on S. 68th St. Due to the complaint I stopped Kyle to determine what his involvement was in the fight. When I first observed Kyle he had a case for his pool "cue" slung over his shoulder and he was bleeding from the right side of his face. I asked Kyle what happened inside the bar and he provided very little details. When I made contact with Kyle several other people also came up to me and said they contacted the Police Department about a fight inside Dopp's. As I was attempting to deal with these parties I observed Kyle start to walk in my opposite direction. I advised Kyle to "hold on" while I attempted to deal with these other citizens. Despite telling Kyle this he again started to walk away from me and I had to physically grab him by his arm and tell him to stop walking.

When I did that Kyle became upset with me, saying I never told him to stay on scene. Officer Molthen then responded to my location and took over speaking with Kyle, while I entered Dopp's to see if the fight was still occurring. Once I entered Dopp's I observed multiple people sitting at the bar, drinking alcohol. I observed no fight was taking place and I then motioned for the bartender to come and speak with me. As I was about to start speaking with the bartender I observed an M/W (later verbally identified as Richard M. Schriener M/W 12/13/49) exit the bathroom. When Richard exited the bathroom I observed bruising underneath his left eye, consistent with receiving a

"black eye". Based upon Richard's visibly fresh injury I started to speak with him about what happened tonight.

**ON-SCENE STATEMENT OF RICHARD M. SCHRIENER- VICTIM**

*During my interaction with Richard I could detect an odor of intoxicants on his breath.*

Richard stated he was seated at the bar when he observed a fight break out inside of Dopp's. Richard stated the fight took place near the main entrance door to the bar. Richard did not know why the fight started or anyone involved in the fight. However, Richard believed the fight was between two "table's" of people that were inside the bar. Richard said he attempted to intervene and break up the fight when he was punched in the face. Richard was unable to provide a description of the party that punched him in the face or any idea who it was. I asked Richard if he knew why he was punched in the face and he was unsure. Richard theorized he could have been punched because when he intervened, someone could have mistook it for him actively attempting to fight them.

Richard admitted the bruising underneath his left eye was fresh and a result of being punched. I asked Richard several times if he wanted an ambulance and he declined every time. I asked Richard if he believed he suffered a broken bone as a result of the punch and he stated "no".

Around this time I started conferring with other Officers on scene and it was determined Kyle was apart of the fight that Richard had attempted to break up. I provided Richard with a clothing description of Kyle and asked him if anyone matching that description had punched him and he did not know. Richard was unable to provide a physical or clothing description of anyone involved in the fight and stated it all happened "very fast". I asked Richard if he would be able to identify the person that punched him in a photo line up and he stated "no".

Richard was unable to provide any further information about this incident.

**LACK OF CONSENT**

Richard stated he did not give anyone permission to punch him in the face and cause injury to it.

**NARRATIVE**

Officer Fletcher reports...

**INITIAL CALL**

On 12/10/13 at approx. 2328hrs., officers responded to Dopps, 1753 S. 68 St., for a bar fight. After arriving on scene, I made contact with witness Jon K. Johnson M/W 12/28/55 outside of the bar and spoke with him regarding the incident.

**WITNESS STATEMENT - JON K. JOHNSON**

Johnson advised he was playing pool with his son, "Tony," at the time that the fight began. Johnson advised the fight was between approx. 5-6 people. Johnson believed two younger M/W's, one of which may have been named "Ronny," instigated the fight with a "biker type, bald guy." Johnson was unsure why they began fighting. Johnson stated once the fight began, his son walked over to the group and asked them to stop fighting. Johnson then followed his son, telling him to "stay out of it." While attempting to pull his son away from the fight, Johnson was knocked to the ground by one of the parties that was involved. Johnson and his son then returned to the pool table, and the fight continued for approx. five minutes until the two younger parties left the scene. Johnson was unable to provide any further description of any of the parties involved.

**WITNESS STATEMENT - JANET M. ALAMO**

While on scene, I also made contact with Janet M. Alamo F/W 10/31/63 inside of the bar. Alamo advised she was at the northwest corner of the bar during the entire duration of the fight. Alamo stated there were two separate fights in the bar, both of which were instigated by a "younger" M/W in a blue flannel shirt (later identified as Robinson), along with his M/W friend. Alamo was unfamiliar with any of the parties involved and advised she has never seen them in the bar before. Alamo advised the first fight began between the two "younger" M/W's and a group of three unknown males. Alamo was not sure why they began fighting, but stated the parties fought for approx. five minutes before the group of three males left.

After the first incident ended, Robinson and his friend continued to argue with patrons in the bar. Alamo stated Robinson was then asked to leave, but refused to stop arguing. Robinson then began fighting with two or three other unknown males near the northeast side of the bar. Alamo then shouted for someone to call the cops, and stated she "did not really see much" after the

**NARRATIVE**

Officer Agor reports...

**INITIAL CALL**

On 12-10-13 at 2328 hours, officers responded to Dopp's tavern, located at 1753 S. 68th St., for multiple people fighting. Upon arrival, I made contact with the owner of the establishment, identified as Tammy L. Dopp (F/W 01-23-64), and a bar patron by the name of Karen G. Stier Bohringer (F/W 06-01-65).

**ON SCENE STATEMENT OF TAMMY L. DOPP (WITNESS)**

Tammy, identified by her WI driver's license, reported earlier in the night, she observed two young white males enter the bar. Tammy stated she noticed one of the males, whom she only knew as Ronnie, later identified as Ronald M. Frakes (M/W 10-30-84), was staring other patrons down and making them feel uncomfortable. Tammy believed Ronald was a family member of one of the band members playing that night.

Tammy informed me she observed Ronald get into an argument with multiple patrons inside the bar. Tammy could not tell who started the argument or what the argument was about, but she decided to order Ronald to leave the bar and

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not return for the night. Ronald refused to leave the establishment and yelled to Tammy, "Fuck you. You're a cunt."

At this point, other patrons attempted to assist Tammy with making sure Ronald left the bar. In response, Ronald and the other male he was at the bar with, later identified as Kyle D. Robinson (M/W 05-02-92), started another argument with multiple patrons inside the bar. Both Ronald and Kyle struck multiple patrons before they exited the bar in an unknown direction.

Tammy was unable to give a description of Ronald or Kyle.

**ON SCENE STATEMENT OF KAREN G. STIER BOHRINGER (WITNESS)**

Karen, identified by her WI photo id, reported she arrived at the bar for a Christmas party, when two young white males enter the establishment. Karen noticed both males were drinking throughout the night and causing small disturbances with other patrons. Karen stated she observed Ronald, who was wearing a powder blue plaid shirt with yellow stripes and big white circle earrings, push someone into the wall by the front entrance door, causing a picture on the wall to fall. I observed a frame on the floor close to the entrance, but the picture frame was not damaged.

Karen described the other white male, later identified as Kyle D. Robinson as approximately 6'00" with a goatee, wearing a dark coat. Karen was unaware what happened before Ronald pushed the other patron. Karen then saw Tammy attempt to kick Ronald and Kyle out of the bar. Instead of leaving the bar, both Ronald and Kyle started a second fight with multiple patrons. Ronald and Kyle then exited the bar in an unknown direction.

Officer Gold Reports...

**INITIAL RESPONSE**

On 12/10/13 at approx. 2328hrs, I responded to Dopps Bar 1753 S. 68 St. for a bar fight and on arrival I spoke with witness Isidore NMI Alamo M/U 08/01/53.

**STATEMENT OF ISIDORE NMI ALAMO**

Isidore stated he was seated on the N/E corner of the bar and at one point in the evening he noticed two young M/W's causing problems inside the bar. Isidore described the two as one wearing goofy glasses, a flannel shirt and a pea coat (Identified as Kyle Robinson M/W 05/02/92) and the other as also wearing a flannel shirt (Ronald M. Frakes M/W 10/30/84). Isidore believed the two M/W's were in the company of two females.

Isidore stated the two young M/W's continued to bother people inside the tavern which resulted in the two young M/W's actively fighting two older unknown males. Isidore stated the physical altercation eventually ended and the two older males left. After the two older males left, the young male (Ronald) then confronted another older male (Richard M. Schriener M/W 12/13/49) near the bar. Upon confronting Richard, Ronald punched him in the face for what appeared to be no reason at all. Isidore stated the other young male (Kyle) then attempted to separate Ronald from Richard.

Isidore stated he believed the Police were called after the first altercation and before the second one.

Isidore was adamant that both the young M/W's were the problem this evening and he observed both actively fighting other patrons inside the bar.

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**NARRATIVE****INITIAL CALL****P.O. Mathy reports...**

On 12/10/13 at approximately 2328hrs, I responded to Dopps bar, 1753 S. 68 St., for a trouble call. Upon my arrival the scene was secure and I made contact with several parties inside.

**STATEMENT- JOHN A. SPASARO (COMPLAINANT)**

Upon my arrival I spoke with the caller/ complainant, John A. Spasaro M/W 05/01/51. I asked Spasaro to explain what occurred. Spasaro said he was playing in the band for Dopps tonight when he heard a loud commotion and yelling near the east side entrance door. Spasaro said he observed approximately 4-5 males actively fighting. Spasaro said he did not know their names and did not get a good look at the specific offenders. I asked Spasaro to describe the individuals he observed. Spasaro said he believed two groups of people were fighting. Spasaro said there were two white males, approximately 30 to 40 years of age, who both had several tattoos, fighting with two to three other white males, approximately 30 years old. Spasaro believed the confrontation continued for several minutes and that he called the Police because of the continued fight.

I asked Spasaro if he could describe any more details regarding the individuals involved and he said he could not. Spasaro did not believe he could identify the offenders in a photo. Spasaro did not have any other pertinent information to add regarding the incident.

**STATEMENT- JANEAN A. TAYLOR (BARTENDER)**

After speaking with Spasaro, I made contact with the bartender, Janean A. Taylor F/W 05/09/56. I asked Taylor if she could describe what occurred. Spasaro said the scene was very chaotic and she could not identify who was involved. Taylor said she believed 4-5 males were fighting, varying between 25-40 years of age. Further, Taylor said each male was white, however, she had no other pertinent information to add about her observations. I asked Taylor if she called the Police and she said she did not because she heard that someone already called.

**STATEMENT- TAMMY L. DOPP (WITNESS)**

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While on scene I made contact with the bar owner, Tammy L. Dopp F/W 01/23/64, who said she observed portions of the fight. Dopp said she observed two younger white males fighting with two older white males. Dopp said she specifically observed a male whom she knows as Ronald, described as a white male, approximately 5'9 160 pounds, with blue eyes and blond hair, punch an older white male. Dopp said Ronald was a regular at the bar and that she believed he was instigating the fight. Dopp said she could indentify Ronald in a photo line-up and that he left his credit card at the bar. Dopp did not have contact information or an address for Ronald. I asked Dopp if she could describe the sequence of events leading to the fight and she said she could not. During my contact with Dopp it appeared that she was intoxicated as a strong odor of alcohol was emitting from her breath and her speech was slurred.

**STATEMENT- MICHAEL E. PIETRZYKOWSKI (VICTIM)**

Finally, I spoke with the victim, Michael E. Pietrzykowski M/W 01/12/53, who said he was elbowed in the back of the head during the fight. Pietrzykowski said he observed two younger white males fighting with two older white males. Pietrzykowski said he attempted to stop the fight was subsequently elbowed in the back of the head. Pietrzykowski said the same male then struck him in the face, at which point Pietrzykowski temporarily held the offender by the neck. Pietrzykowski said he released the offender and he fled the scene. Pietrzykowski described the offender that struck him as a white male, approximately 6'0, approximately 27 years old, 180-200lbs, with short blond hair. Pietrzykowski was confident he could identify the offender by photo line-up. Pietrzykowski said he wanted the offender arrested for the offense and Pietrzykowski had a number of superficial abrasions.

**Injuries**

Pietrzykowski had dried blood present inside his left ear, a small amount of blood located on the bridge of his nose, as well as a small, approximate one inch laceration on the right side of his face. Pietrzykowski refused medical attention and stated he had no other information in regards to the incident.

**LACK OF CONSENT**

Pietrzykowski did not give anyone permission to punch him in the face, elbow him in the head or cause him pain.
