All the School Board meetings are shown live on Channel 13 with replays throughout the month. In September they showed all the varsity football games of both Hale and Central, which would continue through the rest of the football season. Channel 13's staff and student volunteers also broadcast one event from their other fall sports events including Cross Country, Boys Soccer, Girls Swimming, Girls Tennis and Volleyball.

The District also did a town hall political style debate in conjunction with the Wauwatosa Schools PTA's. Candidates whose districts covered both school districts participated in the event.
