- Because plaintiff's § 1983 claims involve constitutional issues that may be litigated during the course of his criminal case, a stay of all proceedings pursuant to *Younger v. Harris*, 401 U.S. 37 (1971), is warranted.
- Accordingly, this action is **STAYED** until plaintiff's underlying state court criminal proceedings are resolved. The clerk's office shall **ADMINISTRATIVELY CLOSE** this case.
- Plaintiff may file a motion to reopen the case once the court criminal proceedings have concluded.
