Dear Mr. Kuligowski

On Tuesday, August 5th at about 10:40am, the Library custodian walked into the atrium men's restroom and noticed you were naked from the waist down – wearing only a white t-shirt. The library employee immediately contacted me, and I came down and entered the restroom - witnessing you in that state of undress – exposing yourself. I directed you to dress yourself and leave the library. You became argumentative and asked what you were doing wrong, and I stated the obvious – you were exposing yourself in public, and that we have children who use these restrooms. I also told you that police were called.

Before police arrived you exited the restroom and continued arguing with me asking if it was against the law “to live.” I responded it was not, but that it is unlawful and therefore a violation of the Library Code of Conduct policy, to be naked in a public space within the building. You asked where the policy was posted, and I offered to show you the location near the elevator. You declined my offer and left the library.

This is the second incident where complaints have been received that you were unclothed in a public restroom. On June 4, 2025, at approximately 12:55pm a library patron complained to staff that he had witnessed you standing naked in the atrium men's restroom. When the custodian entered he saw you were wearing only a shirt and that you were naked from the waist down. You were asked to leave the building by the librarian in charge.

Your actions are in violation of the West Allis Library Code of Conduct policy. Particularly the following points:


- Committing or attempting to commit any activity in violation of local, state, or federal laws
- Public restrooms should not be used for inappropriate purposes such as bathing, shaving, sleeping, washing clothes, utensils and other personal items; or drying of clothes.

As a result of your actions, your library privileges cease, and you are immediately banned from the West Allis Public Library. **Effective immediately, you may not be present in the building or on any part of the library grounds including the parking lot or building entrances.**

At its August 27, 2025, meeting, the West Allis Public Library Board of Trustees will vote to affirm this ban.

If you ignore or violate this order, police will be called, and you will be charged appropriately.
