THE WEST ALLIS COMMON COUNCIL TO THE BREAKING POINT, INC.:

You are hereby notified that a sworn complaint, a copy of which is attached, has been duly made and filed, requesting a hearing on the suspension, revocation or non-renewal of your Class B Intoxicating Liquor and Class B Minted Malt Beverage License, pursuant to the provision of sec. 125.12, Stats.

NOW THEREFORE, you, The Breaking Point, Inc., are hereby summoned to appear before the License and Health Committee of the West Allis Common Council in Room 128 of the West Allis City Hall, 7525 West Greenfield Avenue, West Allis, Wisconsin, on the 28th of February, 2006, at 6:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as this matter can be heard, to admit or deny the allegations in the complaint. You may be represented by counsel on this date.

In the case of your failure to appear as required by this summons, the allegations in the complaint against you shall be taken as true and, if the License and Health Committee of the West Allis Common Council finds the allegations sufficient, a recommendation that your

license(s) be suspended or revoked will be made to the full Common Council. The Common Council may then vote to suspend, revoke, or not renew your license(s).

You are further notified that if you appear as required by this summons and contest the allegations in the complaint, a hearing will be scheduled at a later date before the License and Health Committee, at which time you may be represented by counsel, cross examine the witnesses who testify adversely against you, and present witnesses in your own behalf. A written transcript of said hearing shall be made and you may obtain a copy of the transcript of this proceeding at your expense.

Kurt E. Kopplin, being duly sworn, on oath deposes and states as a complaint against The Breaking Point, Inc. as follows:

- 1. That the complainant is a resident of the City of West Allis, is the duly elected Alderperson for the second aldermanic district in the City of West Allis, and makes this complaint at the direction of the License and Health Committee of the West Allis Common Council.
- That the information contained in this complaint comes from the complainant's
 review of official records maintained by the City of West Allis, which records
 complainant believes to be reliable and accurate.
- 3. That the Community Development Authority of the City of West Allis acquired the property located at 6415 West Greenfield Avenue by condemnation on December 12, 2002 and that The Breaking Point, Inc. vacated the premises of 6415 West Greenfield Avenue on or about September 30, 2003.
- That subsequent to vacating the premises at 6415 West Greenfield Avenue, The
 Breaking Point, Inc. failed to relocate in the City of West Allis.

5. That on April 22, 2004, The Breaking Point, Inc. applied with the West Allis City Clerk/Treasurer for a renewal of its Class B Intoxicating Liquor and Beer Licenses to operate a tavern and that said application listed the premises as "No Building."

6. That the West Allis Common Council took no action on the 2004 – 2005 license application of The Breaking Point, Inc. due to The Breaking Point, Inc.'s failure to have a location.

7. That on April 27, 2005, The Breaking Point, Inc. filed an application for renewal of its tavern license for the 2005 – 2006 license years. Further, that said application listed the address of the premises as "None."

8. That The Breaking Point, Inc. has failed to conduct license business at an authorized location for a period of 30 consecutive days contrary to section 9.02(9)(c) of the West Allis Revised Municipal Code.

WHEREFORE, Kurt E. Kopplin requests that The Breaking Point, Inc. be summoned to appear before the License and Health Committee of the West Allis Common Council to answer this complaint and, if the material allegations of the complaint are denied, that a hearing be held to determine whether the Class B Tavern License comprised of the Class B Intoxicating Liquor and Class B Minted Malt Beverage Licenses of The Breaking Point, Inc. should be revoked or not renewed.
