SCOPE OF SERVICES

Task I. Pre-Design

- Conduct background research and data collection. Coordinate the proposed site improvements for project areas to include topography, underground utilities, drainage patterns, existing structures, and vegetation.
- Attend kick-off meeting with city staff (Meeting #1). This meeting will address topics including:
 - Design program
 - Project timeline and meeting dates
 - Priorities and restrictions
 - Design character
 - Budget constraints (construction and ongoing maintenance)
- Attend and facilitate a neighborhood listening session/interactive charrette (Meeting #2) to develop schematic ideas for the new park.
- Prepare 2 preliminary concepts for the new park for neighborhood review. Concepts will be color rendered schematic layout plans.
- Refine concepts into one final rendered plan graphic based on city feedback.
- Prepare opinion of probable construction cost for improvements.
- Communicate on a regular basis with city staff via conference call and/or email.
