

**AMENDMENT OF EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT
WITH JOHN F. STIBAL, DIRECTOR OF DEVELOPMENT,
REGARDING THE WISCONSIN RETIREMENT FUND**

This amendment made and entered into by and between the City of West Allis, a municipal corporation organized and existing by virtue of the laws of the State of Wisconsin, and Mr. John F. Stibal, currently residing at [REDACTED].

WHEREAS, the City of West Allis currently employs Mr. John F. Stibal in the position of Director of Development under the terms of the Employment Contract dated September 21, 1989; and,

WHEREAS, said Employment Contract includes Paragraph G on Page 3, on the subject of the Wisconsin Retirement Fund; and,

WHEREAS, said provision needs to be amended to bring it into compliance with new, similar Wisconsin State Law provisions on employee/employer cost sharing provisions of the Wisconsin Retirement Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed by and between the City of West Allis and Mr. John F. Stibal that the wording of Paragraph G, on Page 3 (Wisconsin Retirement Fund), be deleted and replaced with the following wording:

“The City and the Director shall pay their respective employer and employee shares to the Wisconsin Retirement Fund as specified by State law.”

This change constitutes a formal, written amendment between the parties hereto and no verbal statement shall supersede any of its provisions.
