With this application, I would like to request that the name of South 66th Street, between Greenfield Avenue and Lapham Street, be changed to Six Points Crossing in order to reinforce the new identity being created by the development of the three block Six Points development.

The new street name would not affect any addresses of any current buildings. Furthermore, the name change would appropriately compliment the new up-scale image being created by the new gateway steel arch which will be suspended above 66th Street (at the Greenfield Ave. intersection), the renovation of the historic Farmers Market and the surrounding development. It would also be a strikingly memorable street name for what is envisioned to become the main gateway into the Farmers Market from the Summit Office Park development and a primary pedestrian path between the main streets of Greenfield and National avenues. It would also reinforce the quality image of the development by changing the street name from a forgettable ordinary street number to a named street which conjures up creative positive images of the surrounding area.
