Upon consideration of the complaint presented at the License and Health Committee meeting held on September 1, 2020, the License and Health Committee Finds:

**Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law:**

- 1) That Leonard Perrin appeared for his hearing related to the summons and complaint in this matter and had been appropriately served with a copy of the summons and complaint.
- 2) That at the hearing on September 1, 2020, Leonard Perrin did review the summons and complaint and admitted to the allegations in the complaint, including the conviction for a first offense operating while intoxicated offense stemming from an incident date of November 5, 2019.
- 3) That Leonard Perrin did engage in treatment and assessments required by state law in order to obtain his driver's license back.
- 4) That Leonard Perrin did testify and provide competent evidence of sufficient rehabilitation and fitness to perform the licensed activity contemplated on his renewal application for an operator's permit.

**Recommendation:**

Therefore, the License and Health Committee recommends to the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the Operator's Permit 8852 be granted to Leonard Permit for the license period ending June 30, 2022.
