Dear Mr. Lewis:

Per our conversation this date, please accept this letter as our request for a "Grant of Privilege" for the purpose of improving (paving) the gravel driveway to our property at 112th National.

As discussed, our situation is a little unique because while this is an "unimproved City right-of-way" it is the only access to my land locked property at 112th and National, and my mothers home at 2981 S. 112th. The City has indicated to us that this roadway would never be utilized by the City and has since posted a private drive sign at the entrance. Our family has consistently resided in the two properties since they were built, ours in 1917 and my mother's in 1958. During this time we have maintained this driveway at our own expense, including adding gravel, plowing and mowing. The gravel is extremely dusty and we would like the ability to asphalt the drive to cut down on the dust and dirt that settles on our home, along with easing the maintenance and improving the appearance of this roadway to our home.

You had indicated that there may be a minor insurance issue associated with the Grant of Privilege. I work for the City of Wauwatosa and in discussions with the Public Works Director, Bill Kappel, he suggested that in similar situations a "hold harmless" agreement, in lieu of insurance had been utilized. Would that be a possibility to circumvent this minor issue?

Thank you for your consideration and direction on this matter. I look forward to your approval regarding this request.
