Resolution Granting a Gas Distribution Easement to Wisconsin Gas Company, d/b/a We Energies, to Install a Gas Main on that Portion of Vacated West Walker Street Between South 70th and 72nd Streets.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of West Allis on Resolution No. 25803, adopted July 7, 1998, granted a thirty (30) foot wide easement to the Wisconsin Gas Company for the purpose of maintaining a gas line in the vacated West Walker Street, recorded on Certified Survey Map No. 6525 on June 3, 1998; and,

WHEREAS, the Common Council sold a vacant lot for the construction of an office building adjacent to the above-referenced Wisconsin Gas Company easement to Summit Place LLC on Resolution No. R2002-0159, adopted March 4, 2003; and,

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Gas Company, d/b/a We Energies, is requesting to enlarge the thirty (30) foot wide easement to a sixty (60) foot easement to accommodate the new development along South 70th Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of West Allis as follows:

- 1. That the Gas Distribution Easement from the City of West Allis to the Wisconsin Gas Company, d/b/a We Energies, to increase the easement from thirty (30) feet to sixty (60) feet on that portion of vacated West Walker Street between South 70th and 72nd Streets, in the form attached hereto and incorporated by reference, be and the same is hereby approved
- 2. That the Mayor and the City Administrative Officer, Clerk/Treasurer be and are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the attached Gas Distribution Easement on behalf of the City of West Allis.

For good and valuable consideration which, City of West Allis, hereinafter referred to as "grantor", owner of land, acknowledges receipt of, grants and warrants to WISCONSIN GAS COMPANY a Wisconsin Corporation doing business as We ENERGIES, hereinafter referred to as "grantee", a permanent easement upon, within and beneath a part of grantor's land hereinafter referred to as "easement area".

The easement area is described as:

A 60 foot wide easement, being the vacated W. Walker St. located between S. 70th St. and S. 72nd St. as shown on Certified Survey Map No. 6525 as Document No. 7542540 as recorded in the Milwaukee County Register of Deeds Office and being part of the NE ¼ of the SW ¼ of Section 34, Town 7 North, Range 21 East, in the City of West Allis, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin and is described as follows:

Commencing at the NW corner of Parcel 3 of CSM No. 6525 and is the point of beginning of said easement; thence East along the South right of way line of W. Walker St., N 89°43'00" E, 568 feet; thence North 60 feet; thence S 89°43'00" W, 568 feet; thence South 60 feet to the point of beginning.

This easement supersedes the Corporation Easement recorded on Reel 4366 as Image 2162-2163 as Document No. 7577970 as recorded in the Milwaukee County Register of Deeds Office on August 6, 1998 at 2:55 p.m.

- 1. Purpose: The purpose of this easement is to install, operate, maintain, repair, replace and extend underground facilities, pipeline or pipelines with valves, tieovers, main laterals and service laterals, together with all necessary and appurtenant underground equipment and including cathodic protection apparatus used for corrosion control, as deemed necessary by grantee, for the transmission and distribution of natural gas and all by-products thereof, or any liquids, gases or substances which can or may be transported or distributed through a pipeline. Trees, bushes, branches and roots may be trimmed or removed so as not to interfere with grantee's use of the easement area.
- 2. Access: Grantee or its agents shall have the right to enter the grantor's land for the purpose of exercising its rights in the easement area.
- 3. Buildings or Other Structures: Grantor covenants and agrees that no structures will be erected in the easement area which will interfere with the full enjoyment and use of the rights herein granted.
- 4. Elevation: Grantor agrees that the elevation of the ground surface existing as of the date of the initial installation of grantee's facilities, within the easement area will not be altered by more than 4 inches without the written consent of the grantee.

- 5. Restoration: Grantee agrees to restore or cause to have restored the grantor's land as nearly as is reasonably possible to the condition existing prior to such entry by the grantee or its agents. This restoration however, does not apply to any trees, bushes, branches or roots, which may interfere with grantee's use of the easement area.
- 6. Exercise of Rights: It is agree that the complete exercise of the rights herein conveyed may be gradual and not fully exercised until some time in the future and that none of the rights herein granted shall be lost by non-use.
- 7. This grant of easement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefits of the heirs, successors and assigns of all parties hereto.
