1. REVIEW OF NEW LEGISLATION

SB121 ARBITRATION AND FAIR SHARE AGREEMENTS
Refer to Audrey Key and Scott Post.

AB142 DEFINITION OF WASTE TREATMENT FACILITY FOR PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION PURPOSES
OPPOSE, because the bill would make permanent an exemption from property taxes for all waste treatment facilities based on a recent court decision.

SB122 PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR MANUFACTURERS' WASTE TREATMENT FACILITIES
FAVOR, because the bill would close the property tax exemption loophole for manufacturers that recycle material as part of the manufacturing process.

OPPOSE, because the bill would eliminate the property tax on personal property, thus losing substantial commercial and industrial tax base and shifting it to residential property taxpayers.

SB148 **EXEMPTING ASSESSORS FROM TRESPASS**

FAVOR, because the bill would provide exemption for city assessor staff from trespass liability and creating civil liability immunity.

SB150 **STATEWIDE BAN ON SMOKING IN PLACES OF EMPLOYMENT**
