**RESOLUTION APPROVING A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT
WITH THE WEST ALLIS PROFESSIONAL POLICE ASSOCIATION FOR 2026-
2029**

WHEREAS, the current labor agreement with the West Allis Professional Police Association ("WAPPA"), ends on December 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City and WAPPA have entered into negotiations for a voluntary successor agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City's labor negotiator and WAPPA have reached a tentative settlement agreement for the four-year period from January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2029; and

WHEREAS, the membership of WAPPA is voting on whether to ratify the tentative agreement on November 10;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City Of West Allis, in the State of Wisconsin, that the collective bargaining agreement attached to this file between the City and the West Allis Professional Police Association for the four-year period from January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2029, is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proper City officers and representatives are hereby authorized and directed to execute the collective bargaining agreement on behalf of the City.
