Upon deliberation and consideration of the complaint presented at the License and Health Committee meeting held on November 18, 2014, the Committee finds:

## FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. That Abigail Sindelar was served a copy of the summons and complaint;
- 2. That Abigail Sindelar failed to appear to contest the complaint and, thus, the allegations in the complaint are considered to be true;
- 3. That the conduct of Abigail Sindelar described in the complaint substantially relates to the alcohol beverage licensed activity contrary to Wis. Stat. § 125.04(5)(b);
- 4. That in particular, Abigail Sindelar's failure to notify the police about the altercation that occurred in the tavern and the firearm that was present in the tavern is contrary to Wis. Stat. § 125.04(5)(b).

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

1. That the foregoing constitutes a sufficient basis to revoke and not renew the Class "I" Operator's License of Abigail Sindelar.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Therefore, the License and Health Committee recommends to the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the Class "I" Operator's License of Abigail Sindelar be revoked and not renewed.
