NOTICE TO ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF WEST ALLIS, WISCONSIN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following initial resolutions have been adopted at the meeting of the Common Council of the City of West Allis held March 15, 2005:

RESOLUTION NO.

INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING \$1,000,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE CITY OF WEST ALLIS FOR SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENTS

RESOLVED that the City of West Allis, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, borrow an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000 by issuing its general obligation bonds for the public purpose of financing sanitary sewer improvements.

RESOLUTION NO.

INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING \$1,100,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE CITY OF WEST ALLIS FOR WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS

RESOLVED that the City of West Allis, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, borrow an amount not to exceed \$1,100,000 by issuing its general obligation bonds for the public purpose of financing water system improvements.

RESOLUTION NO.

INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING \$2,500,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE CITY OF WEST ALLIS FOR STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

RESOLVED that the City of West Allis, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, borrow an amount not to exceed \$2,500,000 by issuing its general obligation bonds for the public purpose of financing street improvement projects.

RESOLUTION NO. ___

INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING \$200,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE CITY OF WEST ALLIS FOR LIBRARY PROJECTS

RESOLVED that the City of West Allis, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, borrow an amount not to exceed \$200,000 by issuing its general obligation bonds for the public purpose of financing library projects.

RESOLUTION NO.

INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING \$8,030,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE CITY OF WEST ALLIS FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS IN TAX INCREMENTAL DISTRICT NO. 5

RESOLVED that the City of West Allis, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, borrow an amount not to exceed \$8,030,000 by issuing its general obligation bonds for the public purpose of providing financial assistance to community development projects under Section 66.1105, Wisconsin Statutes, in the City's Tax Incremental District No. 5.

The Wisconsin Statutes (s. 67.05(7)(b)) provide that the initial resolutions need not be submitted to the electors unless within 30 days after adoption of the initial resolutions a petition is filed in the City Clerk's office requesting a referendum. This petition must be signed by electors numbering at least 10% of the votes cast for governor in the City at the last general election. A petition may be filed with respect to any one or more of the initial resolutions.
