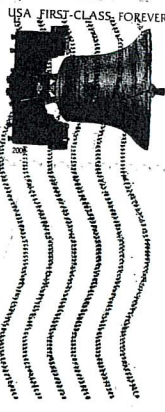

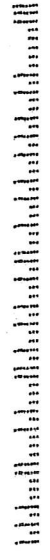

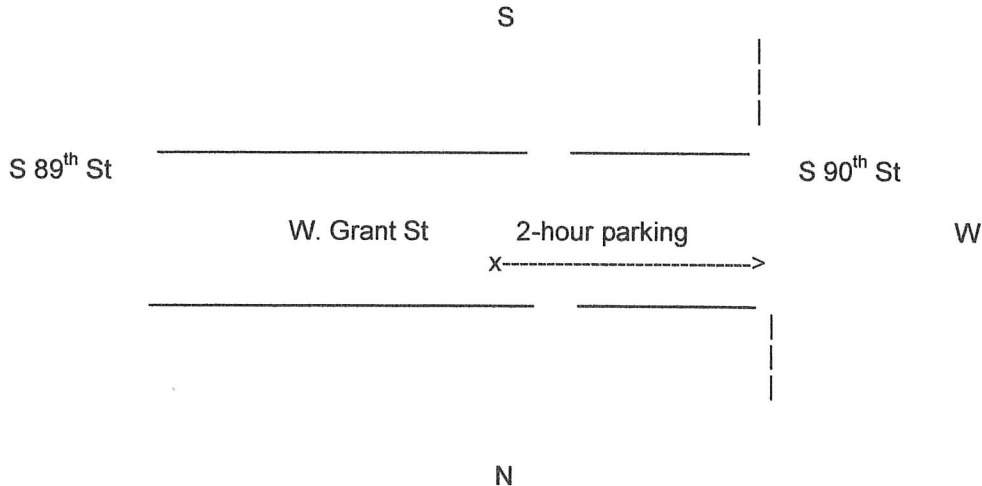
West Allis Common Council members:

This is a request for a (permanent) two-hour parking restriction on the north side of W Grant St, just east of the city access sidewalk to the intersection of W Grant St and S 90th St. I have owned my duplex at 2184 S 90th St for almost 30 years and have noticed quite an increase in traffic on both of these streets. My tenant and I are really the only 2 people who would be able to sign a petition for this request, but I'm sure if I stopped all of the school bus drivers, refuse truck drivers, recycling truck drivers, delivery truck drivers, leaf collection truck drivers, snow plow drivers, and car drivers who frequently use this intersection, I would obtain a huge number of signatures, as navigating this intersection when there are cars parked on both sides of Grant St is quite difficult and dangerous.

My tenant and I both have elderly relatives who would love to come and visit for a short time, but there are always vehicles parked and blocking the sidewalk, making it impossible for them to visit. Since there is a fire hydrant on the 90th St part of my property, parking there is not an option for them. We feel that a two-hour restriction (all day/night, every day/night) would allow our elderly relatives to visit. With winter fast approaching, the restriction would also allow all traffic to navigate this corner in a safe manner. I appreciate your attention to this matter and I'm sure all the vehicle drivers do, too!
