Resolution relative to accepting the proposal of Motorola Corporation for furnishing trunked radio equipment for a total of \$91,097.00.

WHEREAS, The Purchasing/Central Services Division has reported that it has received a proposal for furnishing a two-way radio control station and network equipment for the City of West Allis, that the proposal received was reasonable; and,

WHEREAS, the Purchasing/Central Services Division of the Department of Administration & Finance has determined that this contract is inappropriate for competitive selection due to the proprietary design of trunked radio equipment; and,

WHEREAS, The Common Council deems it to be in the best interests of the City of West Allis that the proposal of Motorola Corporation be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of West Allis that the proposal dated January 20, 2004 submitted by Motorola Corporation for furnishing dispatch and repeater equipment to migrate the existing radio equipment to the Milwaukee County trunked radio system for the total net sum of \$91,097.00 be and is hereby accepted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Purchasing/Central Services Division be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the aforesaid equipment.
