The following is a summary of reported incidents involving licensed businesses, including reported tavern violations and calls for police service during the month of April.

Incident reports:

Case #16-10253, 03/20/2016, 0019 hrs: 6108 W. Burnham St - Fiddler's Green (Late reporting.)

On 03/20/2016, Officers responded to Fiddler's Green for a Disorderly Conduct complaint. The bartender reported a patron was acting strange, causing problems in the bar and spitting at customers. The party was placed under arrest and issued a municipal citation for Disorderly Conduct.

Case #16-11869, 04/01/2016, 2337 hrs: 6426 W. Greenfield Av - Spotlite

On 04/01/2016, Officers responded to the Spotlite for a report of a belligerent employee that was out of control. The employee left before officers arrived on scene. Officers located and stopped the employee who was driving her vehicle. The woman refused to exit her vehicle, resisted arrest and punched the officer in the chest with a closed fist. She was arrested and given a municipal citation for Resisting an Officer, booked, and released.

Case #16-12918, 04/09/2016, 2249 hrs: 6200 W. Greenfield Av – Six Points Pub & Grill

On 04/09/2016, Officers responded to a trouble call at Six Points Pub and Grill, involving two intoxicated males physically fighting with patrons inside the bar. Officers made contact with the bar employee who advised parties assaulted several patrons in the bar which were no longer on

scene. The Officer made contact with the two Offenders and issued them municipal citations for Disorderly Conduct.
